ONLINE MOP UP ALLOTMENT TO DNB (POST MBBS)/
DNB (POST DIPLOMA) COURSES-2022
ONLINE OPTIONS INVITED

The activities related to the Online Mop Up Allotment to DNB (Post MBBS) / DNB - (Post Diploma) courses for the year 2022 in the State have commenced from **24.11.2022**. This allotment will be conducted to fill up the vacant seats after the first allotment and the seats expected to be released during the allotment process of the Online Mop Up round. Eligible candidates included in the DNB (Post MBBS) / DNB – (Post Diploma) Rank list published by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations can register their options online through the website **www.cee.kerala.gov.in** from **24.11.2022 to 26.11.2022, 10.00 AM**.

Candidates may enter their Application Number & Password in the link '**DNB -Post MBBS / DNB –Post Diploma Candidate Portal**' provided in the above website to log on to their home page. Then by clicking the menu item '**Mop-up Option Registration**', candidates can register their options online. The Provisional Allotment List based on the rank list and the online options received up to **10.00 am on 26.11.2022**, will be published on **26.11.2022**. Candidates who get allotment shall have to join the allotted colleges by paying the fees to the allotted college. The schedule of joining will be notified later.

All details related to the counseling/allotment process are available in the Information Bulletin for admission to DNB (Post MBBS)/ DNB (Post Diploma) Courses-2022 available

on the website **www.cee.kerala.gov.in**, of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.

After the Mop-up allotment, if any vacancies exist or arise, those vacancies shall be filled through stray vacancy allotment by considering the options registered by the candidates during the mop-up round. Vacancies exist after the initial stray vacancy allotment, additional stray vacancy allotment may be conducted by forwarding list of eligible candidates to the colleges where vacancies exist and the allotment shall be done at the college level based on the guidelines issued by the Commissioner for entrance Examinations at that time. The various list of candidates for the college level stray vacancy filling after the mop-up allotment will be prepared based on the options registered for the mop-up allotment process. So, candidates who intend to participate in the institution level stray vacancy filling should participate in the mop-up allotment also by registering fresh options for the mop-up allotment.
