ALLOTMENT TO DNB (Post MBBS) STATE QUOTA SEATS 2020-21 ONLINE OPTIONS INVITED

The Centralised Allotment Process (CAP) for admission to State Quota seats in DNB (Post MBBS) Courses for the academic year 2020-21 commences on **19.08.2020** (Wednesday).

The Candidates who have been included in the State Rank List for the course can register their online options through the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in from 19.08.2020 to 21.08.2020, 2.00 pm. Candidate may enter their Application Number & Password in the link 'DNB (Post MBBS) 2020 - Candidate Portal' provided in the above website to log on to their home page. Then by clicking the menu item 'Option Registration' candidates can register their options online. The first allotment to be published 21.08.2020 will be based on the online options received within the stipulated time.

The Online options of the candidates will not be considered for the allotment, if they fail to rectify the defects in their online application in proof of their claim within the stipulated time.

The schedule for the allotment is given below:

19.08.2020	Website opens for Option Registration
21.08.2020, 2.00 pm	Time for Option Registration ends
21.08.2020	Allotment Publication
21.08.2020 - 23.08.2020, 3.00 pm	Remittance of Fee:- All candidates who get an allotment should remit the fee to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations as shown in the allotment memo at selected branches of Head Post Office or by way of Online Payment.
Joining Schedule will be published later	

Candidates can select options as per their priority of the Course-College combinations in the option list. A candidate need only give options to a Course-College combination if he/she is sure to join the course and college, if allotted.

In view of the pandemic situation to covid-19 those candidates who get an allotment in this phase are instructed to ensure their seats through online fee remittance only. Those who complete the online remittance of fees will be provided with a **Fee Remittance Slip**.

Candidates who do not remit the prescribed fees will lose their allotment as well as the claims for further online allotments, if any. Online options registered in this phase will be the basis of further online allotment if any.

In the light of the restrictions imposed consequent to the wide spread Covid-19 virus, candidates are instructed to ensure in advance that the documents as mentioned in

clause 10 of the Information Bulletin for DNB (Post MBBS) courses 2020 are ready with them to be produced at the time of admission.

Note: 1. Candidates are advised not to give unnecessary options to courses/colleges where they do not wish to join, if allotted. All details related to the allotment process are available in the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in.

2. Candidates who fail to register their options online will not be considered for allotment under any circumstances. Options submitted to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations by Fax/Post/Hand delivery will not be processed or considered on any account for the allotment of seats.
