ORDER

As per the Government Order read above , Government had approved the Prospectus/Information Bulletin for admission to DNB Post MBBS and Post Diploma Courses, for the academic year 2020-21 . Now the Director of Health Services, as per the letter read as 3rd paper above has requested to modify the certain clauses of the approved prospectus/Information Bulletin on the basis of Government of India direction.

2) Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to modify the following amendments in the approved prospectus/Information Bulletin as given below.Government are also pleased to incorporate the Annexure for the courses as appended to this order.

INFORMATION BULLETIN FOR DNB-POST MBBS STATE QUOTA 2020

I) Clause 7 of the Information Bulletin is modified as,

7. QUALIFYING CRITERIA:

All candidates seeking admission to the state quota seats of DNB (Post MBBS) Courses in the State of Kerala for the academic year 2020-21 shall have to qualify the National Eligibility Cum Entrance Test for Post-Graduate Medical Courses (NEET PG- 2020) conducted by the National Board of Examination, New Delhi. In order to be eligible for admission in any DNB

(Post MBBS) course in 2020-21, it shall be necessary for a candidate to obtain a minimum of marks at 30th percentile in the NEET PG 2020. However, in respect of candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes (SC), Scheduled Tribes (ST), Socially and Educationally Backward Classes (SEBC), SC- PD, ST-PD, SEBC- PD, the minimum marks shall be at 20th percentile. In respect of UR-PD candidates, the minimum marks shall be at 25th percentile.

9. APPLICATION FEE

Candidates are required to pay the Application fee of Rs. 1000/- (excluding of payment gateway charges). But, in the case of SC/ST candidates and those eligible for SC/ST benefits as per G.O (Ms) No.25/2005/SCSTDD dated 20.06.2005, the application fee to be paid is Rs.500/-(excluding payment gateway charges).

Application fee shall not be refunded under any circumstances.
