ADMISSION TO PG MEDICAL /DNB (POST MBBS) COURSES 2022 SPECIAL STRAY VACANCY FILLING ALLOTMENT AND ELIGIBLE CANDIDATE LISTS PUBLISHED

The vacancies in PG Medical Courses including Service Quota Seats in Government/Private Medical colleges and DNB (Post MBBS) courses have been published in the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in vide notification dated 06.01.2023. These vacancies will be filled up at the respective colleges based on the list forwarded by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations and in accordance with the Guidelines issued by the CEE.

Three Lists have been issued for this phase of Stray Vacancy filling round of admission.

List 1,Allotment List: List has been prepared based on options registered by the candidates for Special stray vacancy filling and vacancies available.

List 2, Probable List: List has been prepared based on options registered by the candidates for Special stray vacancy filling.

List 3, Eligible Candidate List: Includes those candidates who are eligible to be considered for admission.

Candidates shall be considered from these list based on the priority levels. Candidates can check the Lists and guidelines that have been published in the official website of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations. Candidates included in the Lists, may contact the college authorities concerned and participate in the allotment process from 11.01.2023 to 13.01.2023, 2.00 PM. Candidates should submit documents as per clause 10.1.22 (for PG Medical Courses) and as per clause 5 (for DNB (Post MBBS) courses and shall remit the entire fee at the time of admission before 13.01.2023, 4.00 PM.

If any candidate vacates a seat joined in Stray Vacancy Allotment or vacates a joined seat (joined in any of the previous round also) after stray vacancy allotment process he/she will be liable to pay liquidated damages amounting to **Rs.50,00,000** (Rupees Fifty lakhs) for PG Medical courses and pay liquidated damages as per Prospectus clause 6 for DNB (post MBBS) courses to the CEE and will be liable for revenue recovery if not paid. A candidate who does not pay the liquidated damages will be debarred from appearing for the

allotment/admission process to PG Medical course for a period extending up to two consecutive years.

Guidelines for Stray Vacancy Filling round allotment have been published in the official website of the Commissioner for Entrance examinations.
