MOP-UP COUNSELLING FOR BDS COURSE

The Mop-up counselling (Spot Admission) to fill up the vacant seats in BDS course shall be conducted by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations at LMS Women's Centre Conference Hall in the L.M.S. Compound, Palayam, Thiruvananthapuram. The mop-up counselling will start at 10 am on 26.08.2019 and will continue on 27.08.2019, in case the counselling is not completed on 26.08.2019. The candidates who are included in the Kerala State medical rank list published by the CEE, alone can participate in the Mop-up counselling. Those candidates who are admitted through All India counselling cannot participate in the Mop-up counselling. Submission of fresh NRI documents to claim un availed seats under NRI quota is also considered.

Submission of fresh NRI documents to claim un availed seats under NRI quota:

As per the Govt. letter of Health & Family Welfare department, S3/241/2019 dated 03.08.2019, if any vacancy arises after considering the candidates from the NRI list published by CEE in self-financing Dental colleges, it should be filled by the candidates irrespective of their domicile. The candidates included in the medical rank list published by CEE can produce the original documents to prove their claim of NRI at the time of mop-up counselling. No candidates will be allowed to participate in the mop-up without original documents. If any seat remains vacant after allotting all eligible NRI students, the same shall be converted to state merit.

Documents to be submitted:

- 1) Relationship certificate of the Sponsor and student to be issued by the Revenue Authorities (Relationship should be established). If the sponsor is the Father/Mother of the applicant, educational certificates of the applicant containing the name of sponsor shall be accepted.
- 2) Overseas Employment Certificate issued by the Employer, attested by the Embassy and if self-employed, it should also be attested by the Embassy. In the case of non-submission of Embassy Certificate, the endorsement in the passport of the sponsor about the employment by the Embassy/Consulate shall be accepted. Certificate issued by the Embassy/Consulate stating that the Sponsor is a Non Resident Indian (NRI) or an Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) or the Green Card documents shall be accepted in lieu of the Overseas Employment Certificate issued by the Employer and attested by the Embassy.
- 3) Passport with Visa stamped on it and attested by the Embassy.
- 4) A self-affidavit of the relationship between sponsor and the candidate (Sponsorship Certificate).
- 5) The sponsor should be an Indian Citizen/ Overseas citizen of India/ Person of Indian Origin and relevant document to prove the same.
