ENGINEERING RANK LIST, KERALA 2023 – PUBLISHED

The rank list for admission to the Engineering Course 2023 is published herewith. The rank details will be available on the website of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, **www.cee.kerala.gov.in.**

The Entrance Examination for Engineering courses (Paper-I: Physics & Chemistry, Paper – II: Mathematics) was conducted on 17th May 2023. The scores obtained by candidates in the Engineering Entrance Examination were published on 31.05.2023. Those candidates who have qualified in the Examination were directed to submit the marks obtained for Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry/Computer Science/Biotechnology/Biology in the Second year of Plus Two or equivalent Qualifying Examination through the website **www.cee.kerala.gov.in** for the preparation of the Engineering Rank list. Out of 54079 candidates qualified in the Engineering Entrance Examination 49671 candidates have submitted their marks in the second year of the Qualifying Examination to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.

For the preparation of the Engineering Rank list, equal weightage was given to the marks obtained in the Entrance Examination for Engineering (Paper I & Paper II put together) and the grade/marks obtained for Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry/Computer Science/Biotechnology/Biology put together in the Second year of the Qualifying Examination (Plus Two or equivalent), after effecting the standardization procedure as described in Clause 9.7.4 (b)(iii) of the Prospectus for KEAM 2023.

Some of the Boards/Authorities did not provide the statistical parameters/data essential for the process of standardization of marks of those candidates who studied for the Qualifying Examination under that stream. The marks of candidates from such Boards have been standardized based on the criteria decided upon by the Committee constituted vide G.O. (Rt)No.1061/2017/H.Edn dated 07.06.2017.

Marks obtained by the candidate in the Engineering Entrance Examination (Paper I & Paper II put together) are computed out of 300 and added to the total standardized marks of Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry/Computer Science/Biotechnology/Biology as the case may be, in the final year of the Qualifying Examination computed out of 300, both corrected to 4 places of decimals. The rank list for Engineering Courses is then prepared based on the total marks obtained out of 600, computed as above.

The results of some of the candidates in the above Rank list have been withheld due to defects in their application or for other reasons. The results of such candidates will be released as and when the reasons for withholding their results are cleared.

The inclusion of a candidate in the rank list does not entitle him/her for admission to the courses unless he/she satisfies all the conditions of eligibility as prescribed in the Prospectus. Candidates will be admitted to the courses only if the academic eligibility conditions as prescribed in the Prospectus under Clause 6.2 are fulfilled at the time of admission. This will be verified by the college authorities concerned, at the time of admission. The marks in the Qualifying Examination reckoned for preparing the Engineering rank list will be final and will be subjected to verification by the admitting authority. In case, any discrepancy is noticed by the admitting authority in the marks submitted for the preparation of the Engineering Rank List, the candidature will be cancelled. The rank lists for admission to Architecture and Pharmacy courses and the category/community-wise lists based on the rank lists will be published in due course.

The process of allotment for admission to engineering courses for the academic year 2023-24 will be commenced on 01.07.2023.
