CANDIDATES CAN SUBMIT FRESH APPLICATIONS FOR ADMISSION TO MEDICAL & MEDICAL ALLIED COURSES -2023

Fresh online applications are invited for admission to Medical (MBBS, BDS, BHMS (Homoeo), BAMS (Ayurveda), BSMS (Siddha), BUMS (Unani) & Medical Allied courses (BSc. (Hons.) Agriculture, BSc. (Hons.) Forestry ,BSc. (Hons.) Co-operation & Banking, BSc. (Hons.) Climate Change & Environmental Science, B.Tech (Bio-Technology) (under Kerala Agricultural University), Veterinary (BVSc. & AH), Fisheries (BFSc.)) in the State from those candidates, who have not yet submitted applications to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations under KEAM 2023. For Medical & Medical allied courses, only those who have appeared and qualified in NEET-UG 2023 conducted by NTA will be considered.

The facility for online submission of fresh applications will be available in the website <u>www.cee.kerala.gov.in</u> of the Commissioner for Entrance examinations upto **13.07.2023**, **4.00 PM**. *In this phase only those candidates who have not already submitted application to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations under KEAM-2023 can submit online application.*

The candidates who have not submitted applications to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations for admission to Professional Degree Courses through KEAM-2023 can submit fresh online application for admission to Medical & Medical Allied courses. For this, candidates must register through the link **'KEAM 2023-New Application'** provided in the website **www.cee.kerala.gov.in**. On clicking the link, the candidate will be directed to a web page containing the online application. After completing the different steps for submission of the online application illustrated in clause 7.4 of the Prospectus for KEAM 2023, candidate should download the Application Acknowledgement Page and keep a copy of it for future reference. Candidates need not send the printout of the Acknowledgement page or other documents to the office of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.

<u>Payment of Application Fee:</u> The required Application Fee can be paid by way of online payment only.

Important:

Fresh applicants who want to be considered for admission to various reserved category seats based on community or any special reservation or NRI quota or EWS quota (Economically Weaker Section under General Category) or Minority quota or for any income based fee concessions, special reservations should submit, along with the online application, the required supporting documents (Community Certificate, Non Creamy Layer Certificate for State education purpose, EWS certificate for state education purpose, income certificate, NRI documents, etc.as the case may be) to substantiate the claims for reservation or fee concession. There will be no opportunity to submit supporting documents or to rectify the defects in submitted documents after the timeline for submission of online application.

Candidates are required to note that this will be the final chance for submitting online application and for uploading claims/documents to the online application. Thus the details provided and correctness of supporting documents should be strictly adhered to, <u>failing which the claim are liable to</u> <u>be rejected without any further notice/communication.</u>

All candidates are requested to go through the Notification dated, 17.03.2023 and Government approved Prospectus for admission to Engineering, Architecture, Pharmacy, Medical & Medical Allied courses, related Government orders available in the website **www.cee.kerala.gov.in**, before submission of fresh application.
