SECOND PHASE ALLOTMENT TO MBBS/BDS COURSES
FACILITY FOR OPTION CONFIRMATION

The activities related to the second phase of allotment to MBBS/BDS courses for the State Quota Seats available in Govt. Colleges and the total seats available in Self financing colleges began on **18.08.2023**. The allotment to the additional 100 MBBS seats in SUT Medical College, Vattappara, Thiruvananthapuram will also be done in this phase.

Online Option Confirmation is mandatory

Those Candidates who want their higher order options in MBBS/BDS courses to be considered in the second phase of allotment, shall have to log into their Home page and confirm their options by clicking the ‘**confirm**’ button available therein. After Online Option confirmation, the candidates can re-arrange their higher order options/ delete the unwanted options Courses/colleges if applicable, from **18.08.2023** to **22.08.2023 10.00 AM**, through the website **www.cee.kerala.gov.in**. Online option confirmation is mandatory for those who have got admission and those who have no allotment as per the first phase allotment, to consider them in the second phase allotment. But for those who do not confirm their options after first phase of admission, the admission received, if any, in the first phase shall be retained. Those admitted candidates who wish to vacate the seats received through first phase allotment can vacate the seats on or before 21.08.2023, 5.00 PM. such candidates will not be considered for further rounds of centralised allotment to MBBS/BDS courses.

On the basis of options received up to **10.00 AM on 22.08.2023**, the second phase provisional allotment to MBBS/BDS courses will be published in the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in on **25.08.2023**. Candidates who receive allotment in this phase shall have to take a printout of their allotment memo and remit the fee/balance fee (if applicable) payable to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations by way of online payment or through any of the Head Post Offices in Kerala. The list of Post Offices having facility for fee payment is available in the website. After remitting the fee/balance fee (if applicable), the candidates should join the course/college allotted.

DETAILED SCHEDULE OF THE ALLOTMENT

18.08.2023	Website opens for Online Option confirmation and for enabling re-arrangement of higher options/deletion of unwanted options for MBBS/BDS courses
22.08.2023, 10.00 AM	Time for Online Option Confirmation and re-arrangement/deletion of options ends.
25.08.2023	Publication of Second Allotment (Provisional)
26.08.2023	Publication of Second Phase final Allotment
01.09.2023 to 04.09.2023, 4.00 PM	Time for joining to the Allotted colleges after paying required fees.

FEES

The details of fee for the MBBS/BDS courses, in various colleges is available in the website. As the fee for 2023-24 academic year is not yet fixed in Self Financing Medical/Dental colleges, those candidates who got allotment in Self Financing colleges should provisionally pay the fee fixed for 2022-23 academic year and they have to pay the balance fees in case if the fee to be fixed

by the Admission Supervisory Committee/Government/Hon'ble High Court for the academic year 2023-24 is going to be higher than that of 2022-23 for these colleges.

TOKEN FEES

- Those candidates who get allotment to MBBS/BDS courses in Self-financing colleges should pay the fee/balance fee (if applicable) is shown in the allotment memo to Commissioner for Entrance Examinations and should take admission in the allotted college.
- Those candidates who get allotment to Government Medical/Dental courses should pay the complete fee to Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.

Candidates allotted under SC/ST/OEC/Fishermen category and those having benefits as per G.O((MS)25/2005/SCSTDD, dated: 20.06.2005 and G.O(MS)10/2014/BCDD, dated 23.05.2014, and those candidates from Sreechitra Home, Juvenile Home, Nirbhaya Home should not pay the token fee. However, if such students are allotted under Minority/NRI quota seats in Self-Financing Medical/Dental colleges, they will have to remit the token fee as prescribed above and they will not be eligible for any fee concession.

Note:

1. Candidates are advised to file options to the courses/colleges to which they are sure to join and continue studies if allotted, at the time of registration of options.
2. Those NRI, candidates, who have uploaded sworn affidavit from the Sponsor for VISA validity extension as per the directions of Admission Supervisory Committee in order No. ASC 100/23/MBBS/NRI, dtd.14.07.2023 and who among them got allotment in the first phase MBBS/BDS allotment in NRI seats and who are provisionally included in

the NRI category list have to clear the defects on or before **22.08.2023, 10.00 AM** by uploading the valid VISA attested by the Embassy or Consulate. Those candidates who fail to upload the documents will lose the allotment, if any, received under NRI quota in the first phase and the Provisional NRI quota claim of the candidate will also stand cancelled. Such candidates will not be considered for NRI quota seats in subsequent phases of MBBS/BDS allotment.
