# <u>KEAM -2024</u> <u>OPTION CONFIRMATION FOR</u> <u>THIRD PHASE ALLOTMENT TO MBBS/BDS COURSES-2024</u>

The activities related to the third phase allotment to MBBS/BDS courses for the State Quota Seats for the academic year 2024-25 has commenced.

### **Online Option Confirmation is mandatory**

Those Candidates who want their higher order options in MBBS/BDS courses to be considered in the third phase of allotment, shall have to log into their Home page and confirm their options by clicking the 'confirm' button available therein. After Online Option confirmation, the candidates can re-arrange their higher order options/ delete the unwanted options, if 15.10.2024, 5.00 PM. applicable, till through the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in. Online option confirmation is mandatory for those who have got admission and those who have no allotment as per the previous phase allotments, to consider them in the third phase allotment. If the candidate does not confirm his/her options, the existing admission as per the second phase allotment shall be retained. The unallotted seats will be converted during this phase.

On the basis of options received up to **5.00 PM on 15.10.2024** the third phase allotment to MBBS/BDS courses will be published in the website **www.cee.kerala.gov.in** on 16.10.2024. Candidates who receive allotment in this phase shall have to take a printout of their allotment memo and remit the fee/balance fee (if applicable) payable to the Commissioner for Entrance

Examinations by way of online payment or though any of the Head Post Offices in Kerala. The list of Post Offices having facility for fee payment is available in the website. After remitting the fee/balance fee (if applicable), the candidates should join the course/college allotted.

## **TENTATIVE SCHEDULE OF THE ALLOTMENT**

#### FEE

The details of fee for the MBBS/BDS courses, in various colleges is available in the website. As the fee for 2024-25 academic year is not yet fixed in few of the Self Financing Medical/Dental colleges, those candidates who get allotment in these Self Financing colleges should provisionally pay the fee fixed for 2023-24 academic year and they have to pay the balance fees in case if the fee to be fixed by the Admission Supervisory Committee/Government/Hon'ble High Court for the academic year 2024-25 is going to be higher than that of 2023-24 for these colleges.

### TOKEN FEE

- Those candidates who get allotment to MBBS/BDS courses in Selffinancing colleges should pay the fee/balance fee (as applicable) as per the allotment memo to the colleges.
- Those candidates who get allotment to Government Medical/Dental courses should pay the complete fee to Commissioner for Entrance

Examinations.

• Candidates allotted under SC/ST/OEC/Fishermen category and those having benefits as per G.O((MS)25/2005/SCSTDD, dated: 20.06.2005 and G.O(MS)10/2014/BCDD, dated 23.05.2014, and those candidates from Sreechitra Home, Juvenile Home, Nirbhaya Home should not pay the token fee. However, if such candidates are allotted under Minority/NRI quota seats in Self-Financing Medical/Dental colleges, they will have to remit the fee as prescribed above and they will not be eligible for any fee concession.

### Note:

- 1. <u>Candidates are advised to confirm options to the courses/colleges to</u> which they are sure to join and continue studies if allotted.
- 2. If NMC/MCC issues directives that the Third Round All India Quota allotted/admitted candidates become ineligible for Third Round State Quota counseling and if the list of such candidates are shared by the NMC/MCC, the options of such candidates will not be considered for third round allotment in the State, ie., they become ineligible for participating in the third round.
- 3. Those candidates who wish to vacate the seats joined through Phase I & Phase II, can exit the seat by forfeiting the Option Registration fees on or before 15.10.2024, 2.00 PM.
- 4. Those NRI candidates who have submitted expired or expiring Visa along with Online application and have submitted Self declaration from the sponsor can confirm options. If such candidates do not submit the original valid visa/acknowledgement on or before the last date fixed by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations for option confirmation to the Third Phase allotment (ie. on or before **15.10.2024**, **5.00 pm**) to MBBS/BDS courses, the allotment if any, received in NRI quota and the NRI status will be cancelled.

Vacancy in MBBS/BDS course if any exists after the third round allotment will be filled up through Stray Vacancy Allotment. The details of Stray Vacancy Allotment will be published later.
