KERALA ENGINEERING /PHARMACY COMPUTER BASED (CBT) ENTRANCE EXAMINATION -2024 <u>SCORE PUBLISHED</u>

The normalized scores secured by the candidates in the Engineering/Pharmacy Computer Based (CBT) Entrance Examination, Kerala-2024 are published in the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in. Candidates can login to their home page through the link 'KEAM-2024 Candidate Portal' and then click the menu 'Result' to view the Entrance Examination Normalized score.

The final answer key was published in the website. Accordingly on 05.06.2024 One (1) question has been deleted from valuation in Physics section and the score obtained for the remaining 44 questions have been multiplied by (45/ 44) to determine the score in Physics, corrected to four decimal places. One (1) questions has been deleted from valuation in Chemistry Section and the score obtained for the remaining 29 questions have been multiplied by (30/29) to determine the score in Chemistry. In Mathematics Section One (1) questions have been multiplied by (75/74) to determine the score in Mathematics.

On 06.06.2024 Two (2) question has been deleted from valuation in Physics section and the score obtained for the remaining 43 questions have been multiplied by (45/43) to determine the score in Physics, corrected to four decimal places.

On 07.06.2024 Two (2) question has been deleted from valuation in Physics section and the score obtained for the remaining 43 questions have

been multiplied by (45/43) to determine the score in Physics, corrected to four decimal places. One (1) questions has been deleted from valuation in Chemistry Section and the score obtained for the remaining 29 questions have been multiplied by (30/29) to determine the score in Chemistry. In Mathematics Section One (1) question has been deleted and the score obtained for the remaining 74 questions have been multiplied by (75/74) to determine the score in Mathematics.

On 08.06.2024 Two (2) question has been deleted from valuation in Physics section and the score obtained for the remaining 43 questions have been multiplied by (45/43) to determine the score in Physics, corrected to four decimal places. In Mathematics Section two (2) question has been deleted and the score obtained for the remaining 73 questions have been multiplied by (75/73) to determine the score in Mathematics.

On 09.06.2024 Three (3) question has been deleted from valuation in Physics section and the score obtained for the remaining 42 questions have been multiplied by (45/42) to determine the score in Physics, corrected to four decimal places. One (1) questions has been deleted from valuation in Chemistry Section and the score obtained for the remaining 29 questions have been multiplied by (30/29) to determine the score in Chemistry. In Mathematics Section Four (4) question has been deleted and the score obtained for the remaining 71 questions have been multiplied by (75/71) to determine the score in Mathematics.

The scores thus obtained by the candidates in Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry Sections are added to get the total score of the candidate in the Engineering Entrance Examination and the same is normalized. The scores obtained by the candidate in Physics & Chemistry are added to get the total score of the candidate in Pharmacy entrance examination and the same is normalized.

The rank list for Engineering course shall be prepared by giving equal weightage of 50:50 to the normalized score obtained in the Entrance examinations for Engineering and the grade/marks obtained in the final year of the qualifying examination for mathematics, Physics and Chemistry put together, after effecting the standardization procedure as described in clause 9.7.4 (b)(iii). Qualifying in Engineering Entrance Examination is subject to the prospectus clause 9.7.5 (i).

The rank list for B. Pharm course shall be prepared on the basis of the index mark calculated as per clause 9.7.4(f) of the Prospectus for KEAM 2024 out of the normalized score obtained in Physics & Chemistry of the

Engineering/Pharmacy Entrance Examination.
