FIRST PHASE ALLOTMENT TO PHARMACY COURSE -2025 **THIRD PHASE ALLOTMENT TO ARCHITECTURE** **COURSE AND ONLINE STRAY VACANCY ALLOTMENT TO** **GOVERNMENT/AIDED ENGINEERING COLLEGES-2025** **CANDIDATES CAN REGISTER NEW OPTIONS**

The activities related to the First phase allotment to Pharmacy course in the Government and Self Financing Pharmacy colleges, Third phase allotment to Architecture course and Stray vacancy Allotment for admission to Engineering Courses in the Government/Aided Engineering colleges for the year 2025-26 will commence on **18.08.2025** .

Online Option Registration

Candidates who wish to participate in the First phase allotment to Pharmacy course, Third phase allotment to Architecture course and Stray vacancy Allotment to

Engineering Courses shall have to log on to their home Page provided in the website **www.cee.kerala.gov.in** by giving their Application Number & Password through the link '**KEAM 2025 – Candidate Portal**'. Then by clicking the Menu item '**Option Registration**', candidate can register their options online from **18.08.2025 to 22.08.2025, 5.00 PM**

The candidates who get allotment in this phase shall have to join the allotted college with all the original certificates as given in the prospectus clause 11.7.1 before **30.08.2025, 4.00 PM** after remitting the fee as shown in the Allotment Memo, if any, to be paid to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations by way of Online Payment. The balance tuition fee, other fees and the deposits (if applicable) should be remitted in the allotted colleges at the time of admission.

All the College Principals should approve and submit the list of admitted candidates through Online Admission Management System (OAMS) **at 5.00 PM on 30.08.2025**.

I. Pharmacy courses

Mandatory Reservation: Leaving the seats set apart for All India Quota, Government of India Nominees, Special reservation, Persons with Disabilities, all types of supernumerary seats and Management Quota in Government and Self Financing Pharmacy Colleges will be distributed as per the mandatory reservation principle as contemplated in G.O.(P)208/66/Edn. Dated 2.5.1966, G.O.(Ms) No. 95/08/SCSTDD Dated 06.10.2008, G.O.(Ms) No. 10/2014/BCDD Dated 23.05.2014 and as modified from time to time. See Prospectus Clause 4.1.5

The allotment to Colleges will be subject to recognition of All India Regulatory Bodies, Affiliation from the Universities and Government orders.

Candidates who receive allotment should have attained the eligibility for admission as per Clause 6 of the Prospectus at the time of admission. The list of pharmacy colleges participating in the allotment is attached.

II. Architecture course

This phase of allotment will be the last phase allotment for Architecture Course for this year made by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations to Government and Private Self Financing Architecture Colleges. The seats remain vacant in Architecture Course after this allotment will be filled by the Director of Technical Education in the case of Government Colleges and that of other colleges will be filled by the College authorities concerned observing the conditions, rules and regulations contained in the KEAM 2025 Prospectus and Government Orders issued in this regard.

Online option registration for Architecture Course, is a must for those who got allotment/admission and those who got no allotment as per the previous allotments, to consider them in this phase. But those who got an allotment/admission in the previous phases and do not register the admission through the allotment in the previous phase shall be retained.

Those candidates who get allotment in this phase and do not join the college/courses on or before the date prescribed for the same will lose their allotment in the last phase and the allotment in this phase as well as all the options in the stream to which the allotment belongs.

ATTENTION:

Candidates who fail to register options for Architecture Course in this phase will not be considered for allotment under any circumstances.

III. Engineering Courses

The Stray vacancy allotment is conducted for filling the vacancy existing in Government/Aided Engineering colleges. Candidates who have figured in the rank list published by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations and satisfy the eligibility criteria as per Clause 6 in the KEAM 2025 Prospectus can participate in the Stray vacancy allotment. Candidates who got admission in Government/Aided /Private Self financing and Government Cost-sharing colleges in the previous phases, those who have not taken admission after allotment, those who have obtained Transfer

Certificate after admission and those who have not yet received any allotment can participate in this Stray vacancy Allotment process. However the allotment/admission of those candidates who have already taken an admission or take admission in any of the Private Self-financing Engineering colleges will be subject to the orders of the Government in this regard. Those candidates who have already been admitted or take admission in a Government/Aided college/course, and if they get an allotment through this Stray vacancy allotment will lose the existing admission. Candidates can register options to all the courses existing in Government/Aided colleges to which the candidate wish to join as the newly vacant seats due to transfer of students who have already secured admission, will also be filled in this allotment. The options given by the candidates for previous allotments will not be considered for Online Stray vacancy allotment. Those candidates who have not registered their options within the stipulated time will not be considered for this allotment.

Note: *The vacancies, if any, remaining in Engineering courses in Government/Aided colleges after Stray vacancy allotment 5.00 PM on 30.08.2025, shall be filled up through further Online allotment, if any, by considering the same options registered by the candidates for this Stray vacancy allotment . Candidates should take utmost care while registering the options as no facility for re-arrangement or deletion of options will be available in the subsequent Stray vacancy allotments, if any.*

Option Registration Fee:

Those candidates who wish to register options for admission to all courses or any of the above mentioned courses will have to remit registration fee of **Rs.2,000/- (Rupees Two Thousand Only)** to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations subject to the following conditions. **Those candidates who wish to register options for Engineering and Architecture courses afresh and who got allotment in the previous phases and did not take admission will have to remit registration fee .** The registration fee will be adjusted in the tuition fee of those candidates who take admission consequent on allotments. Candidates belonging to SC/ST/OEC category and those having benefits as per G.O.(Ms) No.25/2005/SCSTDD Dated 20.06.2005 and G.O. (Ms)No.10/2014/BCDD Dated 23.05.2014 and those candidates from Juvenile Home, Nirbhaya Home, Sree Chitra Home will have to remit **Rs.500 /- (Rupees Five Hundred only)** as Registration Fee. The Registration Fee of such candidates who take admission in the allotted college/course will be adjusted in the caution deposit. The registration fee of those candidates who do not get allotment will be refunded. For Pharmacy and Architecture courses the Registration Fee of those candidates who do not take admission within the stipulated time after getting an allotment will be treated as penalty and will not be refunded.

For engineering courses the Registration fee of those candidates who do not join within the stipulated time after getting an allotment and those candidates who quit seats after taking admission through Stray vacancy allotment will be considered as penalty and will not be refunded.

Registration Fees can be remitted by way of online payment.

NOTE

The candidates whose results have been withheld due to various reasons can also register their online options for allotment. But the options submitted by such candidates will not be considered for allotment unless they rectify or clear the defects before 3.00 PM on 22.08.2025.
