KEAM-2025 **CENTRALISED SECOND PHASE ALLOTMENT TO** **PHARMACY COURSE PUBLISHED**

The second phase allotment to Pharmacy Course 2025 is published on the website **www.cee.kerala.gov.in**.

The details of allotment of a candidate such as **Name, Roll Number, Allotted College, Category of Allotment, Fee details** etc. will be available on the home page of the candidate as well as in the Allotment Memo.

Allotment Memo and Data Sheet

Candidates who have an allotment should take a printout of Allotment Memo from the home page. The Allotment Memo available in this phase will not be available later. Hence, candidates shall have to keep copy of the Allotment Memo for future reference. Candidates who have an allotment can download the '**Data Sheet**' containing the basic details of the candidates by clicking the menu '**Data Sheet**' available in the home page. The printout of the Allotment Memo and Data Sheet along with the documents prescribed (as applicable) in clause 11.7.1 of the Prospectus are to be produced before the college authorities at the time of admission.

Fee Payment

Candidates who receive an allotment in Pharmacy afresh should remit the fees to be paid to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations as specified in the Allotment Memo by way of **Online Payment** on any date

from **9.09.2025 to 12.09.2025, 2.00 PM** and should join the college allotted before **3.00 PM on 12.09.2025**.

The candidates of Pharmacy Course who get a change in allotment other than that of the first allotment should pay the balance fee, if applicable, within the time mentioned above. These candidates should also join the college allotted as per the Allotment Memo before the time prescribed.

Candidates shall have to remit the fees applicable to the allotted colleges at the time of admission. *Those candidates who do not join the college within the stipulated time will lose their allotment .*
