SECOND PHASE ALLOTMENT TO MBBS/BDS COURSES

FACILITY FOR OPTION CONFIRMATION/REGISTRATION

The activities related to the **Second phase allotment** to MBBS/BDS courses for the State Quota Seats available in Government Colleges and the seats available in Self financing Colleges have commenced.

Online Option Confirmation is mandatory

Those Candidates who want their higher order options in MBBS/BDS courses to be considered in the second phase allotment, shall have to log into their Home page and confirm their options by clicking the ‘**confirm**’ button available therein. After Online Option confirmation, the candidates can re-arrange their higher order options/ delete the unwanted options/ courses/colleges , if applicable, **till 11.09.2026, 10:00 AM**, through the website **www.cee.kerala.gov.in**. **Online option confirmation is mandatory for those who have got admission and those who have no allotment as per the first phase allotment, to consider them in the second phase allotment.** But for those who do not confirm their options after first phase of admission, the admission received, if any, in the first phase shall be retained. Those admitted candidates who wish to vacate the seats received through first phase allotment can vacate the seats on or before **10.09.2026, 5:00 PM**, such candidates will not be considered for further rounds of centralised allotment to MBBS/BDS courses. Candidates who receive allotment in this phase shall have to take a printout of their allotment memo and remit the fee/balance fee (if applicable) and join the course/college allotted.

Option Registration facility will be available for the **NRI Quota seats** under Self-Financing Medical and Dental Colleges. Candidates who wish to seek admission to the NRI Quota seats available in Self-Financing Medical/Dental Colleges shall give their options to such seats in the respective colleges through the website **www.cee.kerala.gov.in** within the stipulated time. Only those candidates who have been included in the NRI Category List published by the CEE will be considered for allotment to NRI Quota seats. Non-Keralite II NRI category candidates will be considered for allotment to NRI Quota seats only in the absence of eligible candidates belonging to the Keralite and Non-Keralite I categories. **Option Registration facility** will also be available during this phase for Azeezia College of Dental Sciences & Research, Kollam. The facility for Option Registration will not be available in the subsequent phase. The **fee details** of the NRI Quota and BDS courses are available in Notification No. CEE/404/2026-TA4 dated 15.08.2026.

11.09.2026, 10:00 AM	Time for Online Option Confirmation and re-arrangement/ deletion of options ends.
11.09.2026	Publication of Second Allotment (Provisional)
12.09.2026	Publication of Second Phase final Allotment
14.09.2026 to 18.09.2026, 4:00 PM	Time for joining to the allotted colleges after paying required fees.
18.09.2026, 5:00 PM	College authorities shall approve and submit the list of admitted candidates through OAMS.

FEES

- Those candidates who get allotment to MBBS/BDS courses in Self-financing colleges should pay the fee/balance fee (if applicable) as shown in the allotment memo to the colleges concerned and should take admission in the allotted college.
- Those candidates who get allotment to Government Medical/Dental courses should pay the complete fee to Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.
- Candidates allotted under SC/ST/OEC/Fishermen category and those having benefits as per G.O((MS)25/2005/SCSTDD, dated: 20.06.2005 and G.O(MS)10/2014/BCDD, dated 23.05.2014, and those candidates

from Sree Chitra Home, Juvenile Home, Nirbhaya Home should not pay the token fee. However, if such students are allotted under Minority/NRI quota seats in Self-Financing Medical/Dental colleges, they will have to remit the token fee as prescribed above and they will not be eligible for any fee concession.

Note:

1. Candidates are advised to confirm options to the courses/colleges to which they are sure to join and continue studies if allotted.
2. The allotment of those candidates who do not take admission within the stipulated time will be lost and such candidates will not be considered for further centralised allotment.
3. The details of fee for the MBBS/BDS courses, in various colleges is available in the website. As the fee for 2026-27 academic year is not yet fixed in Self Financing Medical/Dental colleges, those candidates who get allotment in Self Financing Medical/Dental colleges should provisionally pay the fee fixed for 2025-26 academic year and they have to pay the balance fees in case if the fee to be fixed by the Admission Supervisory Committee/Government/Hon'ble High Court for the academic year 2026-27 is going to be higher than that of 2025-26 for these colleges.
