FRESH OPTION REGISTRATION FOR THIRD PHASE
ALLOTMENT TO MBBS / BDS COURSES - 2026

The activities related to the third phase allotment to MBBS / BDS Courses for the State Quota seats for the academic year 2026 – 27 have commenced.

Fresh Online Option Registration is Mandatory

Fresh Online option registration facility is available for MBBS / BDS courses in the third phase. Eligible candidates included in the Medical rank lists published by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations can register their options through the website **www.cee.kerala.gov.in** till **07.10.2026 , 10:00 am.**

On the basis of options received up to **07.10.2026 , 10:00 am** , the provisional allotment to MBBS / BDS courses will be published on **08.10.2026** and final allotment will be published on **09.10.2026**.

Online option registration for MBBS / BDS courses is a must for those who got allotment/admission and those who got no allotment as per the previous allotments, to consider them in this phase. But those who got an allotment/admission in the previous phases and do not register options for

this phase, the admission through the allotment in the previous phase shall be retained. The unallotted category seats will be converted during this phase as per existing prospectus conditions.

Those candidates who get allotment in this phase and do not join the college/courses on or before the date prescribed for the same will lose their allotment in the last phase and the allotment in this phase as well as all the options in the stream to which the allotment belongs.

14.10.2026, 5:00 PM	College authorities shall approve and submit the list of admitted candidates through OAMS.

Option Registration Fee:

Those candidates who wish to register options afresh and who got allotment in the previous phases but did not take admission or took TC after taking admission, will have to remit registration fee of Rs.5,000/- (Rupees Five Thousand Only) to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations. The registration fee of those candidates, who get an allotment in Government Medical/Dental Colleges, will be carried over to Tuition Fee of the course allotted and the registration fee of those candidates who do not get any allotment will be refunded. The registration fee of those candidates, who get an allotment in Private Self-financing Medical/Dental colleges will be refunded to candidates after closing date of admission, provided he/she has taken admission. Candidates belonging to SC/ST/OEC category and those

having benefits as per G.O.(Ms) No.25/2005/SCSTDD Dated 20.06.2005 and G.O.(Ms)No.10/2014/BCDD Dated 23.05.2014 and those candidates from Juvenile Home, Nirbhaya Home, Sree Chitra Home will have to remit Rs.500 /- (Rupees Five Hundred only) as Registration Fee. The Registration Fee of such candidates who take admission in the allotted college/course will be adjusted in the caution deposit. The registration fee of those candidates who do not get allotment will be refunded. The Registration Fee of those candidates who do not take admission will be treated as penalty and will not be refunded. Registration Fees can be remitted by way of online payment.

FEE

The details of fee for the MBBS/BDS courses, in various colleges is available in the website. As the fee for 2026-27 academic year is not yet fixed in Self Financing Medical/Dental colleges, those candidates who get allotment in these Self Financing colleges should provisionally pay the fee fixed for 2025-26 academic year and they have to pay the balance fees in case if the fee to be fixed by the Admission Supervisory Committee/Government/Hon'ble High Court for the academic year 2026-27 is going to be higher than that of 2025-26 for these colleges.

TOKEN FEE

- Those candidates who get allotment to MBBS/BDS courses in Self-financing colleges should pay the fee/balance fee (as applicable) as per the allotment memo to the colleges.
- Those candidates who get allotment to Government Medical/Dental courses should pay the complete fee to Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.
- Candidates allotted under SC/ST/OEC/Fishermen category and those

having benefits as per G.O((MS)25/2005/SCSTDD, dated: 20.06.2005 and G.O(MS)10/2014/BCDD, dated 23.05.2014, and those candidates from Sreechitra Home, Juvenile Home, Nirbhaya Home need not pay the token fee. However, if such candidates are allotted under Minority/NRI quota seats in Self-Financing Medical/Dental colleges, they will have to remit the fee as prescribed above and they will not be eligible for any fee concession.

Note:

1. Candidates are advised to register options to the courses/colleges to which they are sure to join and continue studies if allotted.
2. If MCC issues directives that the Third Round All India Quota allotted/admitted candidates become ineligible for Third Round State Quota counselling and if the list of such candidates are shared by MCC, the options of such candidates will not be considered for third round allotment in the State, ie., they become ineligible for participating in the third round.
3. Those candidates who wish to vacate the seats joined through Phase I & Phase II, can exit the seat by forfeiting the Option Registration fees on or before **07.10.2026, 10:00 AM.**

Vacancy in MBBS/BDS course if any exists after the third round allotment will be filled up through Stray Vacancy Allotment. The details of Stray Vacancy Allotment will be published later.
