<u>NOTIFICATION</u> <u>KERALA MANAGEMENT APTITUDE TEST</u> <u>SESSION–II ENTRANCE EXAMINATION FOR</u> <u>ADMISSION TO MBA (KMAT-2024)</u> <u>APPLICATIONS INVITED</u>

Applications are invited for the Computer-Based Entrance Examination to the MBA Course, Kerala Management Aptitude Test (Second Session of KMAT-2024).

I. <u>Eligibility:</u>

- i. **Nationality and Nativity:** Indians and Non-Indians are eligible to apply. But only Keralite candidates are eligible for all types of reservations or fee concessions.
- ii. Age: No restrictions.
- iii. Academic qualifications: Candidates should have completed a bachelor's degree of minimum three years duration in the fields of Arts, Science, Engineering, Commerce, Management or equivalent to satisfy the eligibility criteria for the course. Candidates who are appearing for the final year of the qualifying examinations are also eligible to apply, provided their results are declared before the commencement of the admission process for the KMAT 2024. Candidates should have attained the minimum marks stipulated for admission to the MBA course by the respective universities to which they wish to apply.

Note: Documents as proof of applicable eligibility (Nationality and Nativity, reservations, Age, Academic qualification etc.) shall be produced before the College/University authorities at the time of admission. None of these documents need to be uploaded with the online

application or submitted to the Commissioner for Entrance Examination (CEE).

- II. <u>Computer Based Test:</u> The Entrance Examination will be of three hours duration and consist of 180 Objective Type questions of four marks each (Total 180x4=720). For every wrong answer one mark will be deducted. The questions will be based on
- a. English Language Usage and Reading Comprehension (50 Questions),
- b. Quantitative Aptitude (50 Questions),
- c. Data sufficiency and Logical Reasoning (40 Questions),
- d. General Knowledge and current affairs (40 Questions).

Time schedule and other instructions regarding the examination will be notified later.

- III. Qualifying Marks: General category/SEBC candidates who secure cut-off marks of 10% of the total 720 marks, i.e.,72 marks and above, and SC/ST/PD category candidates on secure a cut-off mark of 7.5%, i.e., 54 marks, will be eligible for admission to MBA Course in various Universities/Departments and affiliated management colleges, including Autonomous Colleges in Kerala.
- IV. Submission of Online Application and Application Fee: The application fee is Rs.1,000- (Rupees One Thousand only) for General and SEBC candidates and Rs.500/- (Rupees Five Hundred only) for SC candidates. ST candidates are exempted from paying application fees. (see Annexure I, II and IV of the KMAT 2024 Information Bulletin for SEBC, SC, ST lists). Candidates seeking admission to the course can apply online through the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations till 06.06.2024, 04.00 PM by remitting the required application fee by way of online payment by using Internet Banking/Debit Card/Credit card for online payments. After remitting the fee the candidate has to upload a recent passport size colour photograph and signature to the online application. After completing the application Acknowledgement Page and keep a copy

of it for future reference. Fees will neither be carried forward to a future examination nor be refunded. Applications once submitted cannot be withdrawn. Candidates must note that the mere deduction of fees from the bank account is not proof of fee payment. In the event of a successful payment, the "Pay Application Fee tab" on the online application screen will turn green. If the payment attempt fails, the candidate should make the payment again after ensuring that the Pay Application Fee tab has not turned green even after the next login. If the account is debited in an unsuccessful transaction, under normal circumstances, the steps required to be taken for the deducted amount to be refunded to the same account from which the transaction was attempted, will be completed within 5 working days from the date of the transaction. The Application Acknowledgement page generated after the completion of the online application submission process will contain the payment transaction reference number also.

V. <u>Admit Cards</u>: Candidates who have applied for the entrance examination (Computer Based Test) can download their Admit Cards from the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in from the date to be announced by the CEE. The admit card thus obtained should be brought to the examination hall along with a valid ID Proof. The Commissioner for Entrance Examination will not entertain any request for a change of the date/centres of the entrance examination once declared.

VI. General Instructions:

- Merely appearing and qualifying in KMAT 2024 does not confer any right on the candidate for admission to the MBA Course. The selection and admission to the MBA course is subject to fulfilling the admission criteria, eligibility, and such other criteria as may be prescribed by the Government, Universities, and institutions.
- Applications of candidates submitting false and fabricated information will be rejected, and such candidates will be further debarred from appearing in Examinations conducted by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations. Such candidates are liable to be prosecuted under applicable laws for criminal offense and suitably punished.

- Incomplete applications and applications not in accordance with instructions are liable to be rejected without any further intimation.
- Instructions in the Information Bulletin may change/be updated based on decisions taken by the competent authorities from time to time. Candidates are advised to check regularly the website, **www.cee.kerala.gov.in**, for further updates and information.
- The Commissioner for Entrance Examinations reserves the right to withdraw permission, granted inadvertently if any, to any candidate who is not eligible to appear in the KMAT 2024 even after the Admit Card has been issued by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.
- Candidature for KMAT-2024 is purely provisional and is subject to fulfillment and proof of eligibility criteria prescribed by the admitting institutions as applicable.
