ADMISSION TO FIVE YEAR INTEGRATED LLB COURSES-2024 SECOND PHASE ALLOTMENT ONLINE OPTION CONFIRMATION IS MANDATORY

The activities related to the second phase of Centralised Allotment for admission to Five Year Integrated LL.B Course in the four Government Law Colleges and Private Self- financing Law Colleges of the State for the year 2024-25 commenced on 17.10.2024

Those candidates who received an allotment and taken admission in the allotted college in the first phase, and want their existing higher order options to be considered for the second phase shall have to compulsorily confirm their online options, by clicking the 'Confirm' button available in their home page provided in the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in. The candidate who have exercised options but not allotted to any seats in the first phase should also confirm their options.

After Online Option Confirmation, the candidates can change the priority of existing higher options and delete the unwanted higher options, if desired. The facility for Online Option confirmation/re-arrangement/deletion of options has been made available in the above website. Those who do not confirm their higher options online within the stipulated time will not be included for this phase of allotment. But the present admission, if any, of such candidates during the first phase of allotment shall be retained. The request for option confirmation /re-arrangement/deletion of options received via Post/Fax/e-mail/hand delivery will not be considered under any circumstances.
