**SECOND PHASE OF ALLOTMENT TO LLM COURSES-2020**  
**FACILITY FOR ONLINE REGISTRATION/OPTION CONFIRMATION**

The activities related to the second phase of centralized allotment to LLM course for the year 2020 will commence from **18.12.2020**. This phase of allotment will be done for the vacant seats in Courses in four Government Law Colleges and the Private Self-financing Law Colleges of the State

Candidates who have already submitted online options and who want to participate in this phase of allotment must compulsorily confirm their existing options by clicking the 'Confirm' button available in his/her Home Page. After **online option confirmation**, such candidates can delete the unwanted higher options and can re-arrange their existing higher options. The facility for online option confirmation /deletion/re-arrangement will be available on the Website [www.cee.kerala.gov.in](http://www.cee.kerala.gov.in) from **18.12.2020** to **21.12.2020, 5 pm**. **Those who do not confirm their options through online within the stipulated time, will not be considered for this phase of allotment.**

Candidates who do not remit the prescribed fees/take admission within the stipulated time will lose their allotment as well as the claims for further online allotments, if any.
