## **NOTIFICATION**

### **ENTRANCE EXAMINATION FOR ADMISSION TO LLM COURSE-2021-22** **APPLICATION INVITED**

1. Applications are invited for the Entrance Examination for admission to LL.M Course 2021-22 in Government Law Colleges at Thiruvananthapuram, Ernakulam, Thrissur and Kozhikode and in Private Self Financing Law Colleges in the State which have entered into seat sharing agreement with the State Government.
2. **Eligibility for Admission**
  - (i) **Nativity:** Applicant should be an Indian citizen. However, only those candidates who are of Kerala origin are eligible for any type of reservation or any fee concession. [See clause 5 of the Prospectus]
  - (ii) **Academic qualifications:** Candidates who have passed the L.L.B. examination (5 year / 3 year course) with a minimum of 50% marks from the Universities in Kerala or other Universities recognised by the Universities in Kerala as equivalent thereto are eligible for admission. Candidates appearing / appeared for the regular Final year LL.B. examination can also apply for the Entrance Examination. Such candidates become eligible for admission only if they produce the Provisional / Degree Certificate of the qualifying examination and the mark lists of all parts of the qualifying examination at the time of admission.
  - (iii) **Age:** There is no upper age limit for admission to the LL.M Course.
3. **Online Entrance Examination:** The Online Entrance Examination (Computer Based Test) will be conducted at **Thiruvananthapuram, Ernakulam, Thrissur, Kannur** centres. The date of time of examination will be notified later. There will be two parts of a total of 2 hours duration. Each part will consist of 100 Objective Type questions. The questions will be of the standard of LL.B Examination.
3. **4. Submission of Online Application and Application Fee:** The application fee is Rs.840/- (Rupees eight hundred and forty only) for General and SEBC candidates and Rs.420/- (Rupees four hundred and twenty only) for SC/ST candidates. Candidates seeking admission to the course can apply online through the website [www.cee.kerala.gov.in](http://www.cee.kerala.gov.in) of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations from **20.07.2021 to 28.07.2021, 4.00 pm** and should remit the required application fee **within the date** by way of online payment or by way of e-challan available during the submission of online application [see clause 11.2.3]. Net Banking/Debit Card/Credit Card facility can be used for Online Payment. Payment through e-challan can be made in cash at any of the Head Post Offices in Kerala before 28.07.2021. The candidate who has remitted the fee successfully should upload recent passport size colour photograph/

signature within **28.07.2021,4.00 pm**. However such candidates can upload all other required documents/certificates as mentioned in clause 11.2.4 of the prospectus along with the online application till **05.08.2021, 4.00 pm**. No need to send the printout of the application to the office of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.

### **Certificates/Documents to be uploaded to the Online Application**

**(PDF format from 10 kb to 500 kb)**

- Nationality proof (Election ID/Passport/ Birth certificate/SSLC).
  - Nativity Proof: Any one of the documents mentioned under clause 5.
  - Certificate to prove age: relevant page of SSLC/Birth Certificate/Passport
  - Certificates obtained from Tahsildar in the case of SC/ST candidates.
  - Non-Creamy Layer Certificate (for State Education purpose only) in the prescribed format from the Village Officer concerned in the case of SEBC/OEC candidates.
  - The candidates eligible for EWS Quota seats should submit the EWS Certificate from the concerned Village Officer. (Annexure VI(a), VI(b) of the prospectus)
  - Community Certificate from the Village Officer concerned in the case of OEC candidates who do not come under Non-Creamy layer category.
  - Non-Creamy Layer/Community and Income Certificates from the Village officer concerned in the prescribed format in the case of candidates belonging to the communities listed in Annexure IV (a).
  - Inter-Caste marriage certificate: Candidates who are children of Inter-Caste married couple of whom one is SC/ST, need to upload **Inter-Caste marriage Certificate** issued by Tahsildar.
  - Certificate from the District Medical Board for Persons with Disabilities (if applicable).
  - Certificate from the Fisheries Officer concerned of Kerala Fishermen Welfare Fund Board for fee concession in the case of candidates who are the children of registered Fishermen.
  - Certificate from the Director, Department of Women & Child Development for fee concession in the case of candidates who are inmates of Sri Chitra Home, Nirbhaya Home, Juvenile Home or any other such institution run by the Government.
5. Candidates will not be allowed to include any additional information in the online application form or to submit any certificate/document claiming reservation or any benefits, after the online submission of the application, under any circumstances. Applications in this regard or any such documents will not be accepted in the Office of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.
  6. Certificates submitted should be in the prescribed format available in the website or in the e-district format.
  7. The candidates applied for the online entrance examination can download their **Admit Card** from the website [www.cee.kerala.gov.in](http://www.cee.kerala.gov.in) from the date to be announced later. The admit card thus obtained should be brought to the examination hall.

8. **Allotment of Seats:** The institution-wise allotment will be conducted by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations in accordance with the ranks obtained by the candidates in the Entrance Examination (as per clause 16 of the prospectus) and the order of preference of institutions registered by the candidates during Online Centralised Allotment Process (CAP). The date for CAP will be notified on the website and in leading newspapers. Individual intimation in this regard will not be sent to candidates.
9. The Entrance Examination and subsequent allotments will be based on the provisions laid down in the Prospectus for Admission to LL.M Course, Kerala 2021-22, available in the website [www.cee.kerala.gov.in](http://www.cee.kerala.gov.in). Candidates are advised to read the Prospectus before submitting their applications.
