ADMISSION TO LLM COURSES-2023
MOP UP ALLOTMENT: FRESH OPTIONS INVITED

The activities related to the Mop Up phase of allotment to fill up the vacant seats that exist/arise after the second phase of centralized allotment for admission to LLM Course in the Government Law Colleges and Private Self-financing Law Colleges for the year 2023-24 has commenced. Candidates who have figured in the rank list of LLM Course 2023 published by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations and satisfy the eligibility criteria as per clause 6 of the Prospectus can register fresh options and participate in this phase of allotment.

The schedule for the allotment is given below

02.12.2023	Fresh option registration starts
04.12.2023, 3.00 PM	Fresh Option registration ends
06.12.2023	Publication of provisional Online Allotment
07.12.2023	Publication of final allotment
11.12.2023 to 14.12.2023, 3.00 PM	Candidates to join the allotted colleges
14.12.2023, 4.00 PM	Updation on Online Admission Management System (OAMS) by the colleges.

The candidates who get allotment in this phase shall have to join the allotted college with all the original certificates as given in the prospectus clause 18 within the stipulated time and should remit balance tuition fee, other fees and the deposits (if applicable) in the allotted colleges at the time of admission.

General Rules of Mop-up Allotment:

1. If no seat is allotted to the candidate in the mop-up allotment, the existing admission, if any, shall prevail, and, if a seat is allotted to the candidate in the mop-up allotment, the existing admission, if any, will stand cancelled and the candidate shall have to accept the new allotment.
2. Probable vacancies due to up-gradations to higher options or category conversions will also be filled up in the Mop-up allotment based on the options registered by the candidates for the mop-up allotment. Hence, candidates are advised to take into account, these probable vacancies also in addition to the real vacancies available at the start of the mop-up phase of the allotment process.
3. The seats received through Mop up allotment cannot be changed further at any instance.
4. Candidates who are allotted a seat in the mop-up allotment (irrespective of the admission status) will not be eligible for any subsequent allotments.
5. After the Mop Up Allotment, if vacancies exist/arise, these vacancies shall be filled through Stray Vacancy Filling Allotment. For this round, options registered by candidates during the Mop Up Round will be considered. Notification regarding the same will be issued later.
6. Candidates already admitted to the course through previous phases of allotment by Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, get an allotment through the Mop up allotment, current admission of the candidate will stand cancelled. Hence candidates should register options to only those colleges where they want to study for the course if they get an allotment.

Registration Fees

Those candidates who want to register options only to Govt. Law Colleges shall have to pay an amount of Rs.3780 /- (Amount fixed as Annual Tuition Fee) as registration fee to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations. Those candidates who want to register options to Self Financing Law colleges shall have to pay an amount of Rs.10000/- (one-third of the annual tuition fee of Self financing colleges, subject to a limit of Ten Thousand only) as Registration fee to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations. Candidates can register options to both Government and self Financing Law Colleges by paying an amount applicable to self financing colleges. For SC/ST/OE and other candidates eligible for fee concession registration fee of Rs.1000/- (Rs. One Thousand Only) will be applicable for registering options in Government or Self Financing Colleges.

The registration fee of candidates, who do not get allotment in mop -up phase will be refunded, and the registration fee of those candidates who do not join the course if allotted

through mop up phase will be treated as penalty and will not be refunded.

Candidates who receive allotment should have attained the eligibility for admission as per Clause 6 of the Prospectus at the time of admission.
