NOTIFICATION ADMISSION TO LLM COURSE 2023 FIRST PHASE ALLOTMENT PUBLISHED

The First Phase of Centralized Allotment (CAP) for admission to LLM Course in 4 Government Law Colleges and 9 Private Self-financing Law Colleges which have entered into seat sharing agreement with the State Government for the year 2023-24 is published in the website **www.cee.kerala.gov.in**. Final Allotment List has been published after addressing the valid complaints received from candidates regarding First Phase Provisional Allotment List published on 27.10.2023.

Candidates can access their homepage by entering their application number, and password in the 'LLM 2023-Candidate Portal' provided in the website. Then by clicking the menu 'Allotment Result' candidates can download their allotment memo. The details such as candidate's name, roll number, allotment details, tuition fees etc. are available in the allotment memo. The candidate shall take a print out of the allotment memo. Candidates can log into their Home Page and then click the Menu 'Data Sheet' for downloading the Data Sheet.

Candidates who receive allotment should report for admission to the Principal of the allotted colleges on any date from **02.11.2023** to **08.11.2023**, **3.00 PM** along with the allotment memo and original documents specified in Clause 18 of the Prospectus. They should remit the complete fees as per Government orders to the allotted college at the time of admission. Candidates will be liable to pay the fees at the revised rate as and when the fee for the academic year 2023-24 in the Government Law colleges are revised by the
