ADMISSION TO LLM COURSE - 2024
SECOND PHASE OF CENTRALISED ALLOTMENT
OPTION CONFIRMATION IS MANDATORY

The activities related to the second phase of the Centralised Allotment Process for admission to LLM Course in the Colleges of the State for the year 2024-25 has commenced and available in the website **www.cee.kerala.gov.in** .

Those candidates who have received allotment and taken admission in the allotted college in the first phase, and want their existing higher order options to be considered for the second phase shall have to compulsorily confirm their online options, by clicking the '**Confirm**' button available in the home page provided in the website **www.cee.kerala.gov.in**. Candidates who have exercised options but not allotted to any seats in the first phase should also confirm their options.

In this phase of Option Confirmation, candidates can change the priority of existing higher options and delete unwanted options, if desired. The facility for Online Option confirmation /re-arrangement/deletion of options has been made available in the above website. **Those who do not confirm their higher options online within the stipulated time will not be included in**

this phase of allotment. But the present admission, if any, secured in the first phase of allotment shall be retained. The request for option confirmation/re-arrangement/deletion of options received via Post/Fax/e-mail/hand delivery **will not** be considered under any circumstances.

The following candidates are eligible to participate in the Second Phase of allotment by clicking the 'Confirm' button available on the home page of the Candidate Portal.

- Candidates who received an allotment in the first phase and got admitted to the allotted colleges and continued in their admitted status.
- Candidates who have registered options for the first phase, but did not receive any allotment in the first phase and want to be considered for the second phase of allotment.
- All eligible candidates can register fresh options to the LL.M Criminal Law course in Al Ameen Law College, Kulappully, Shornur, Palakkad as this course-college combination was not available in the first phase of the centralised allotment process.

The schedule for the allotment is given below:

10.12.2024	Option Confirmation /re-arrangement /deletion/addition of options starts
15.12.2024	Option Confirmation /re-arrangement/ deletion/addition of options ends
16.12.2024	Publication of second Phase of Allotment (Provisional)
17.12.2024	Publication of second Phase of Allotment (Final)

Candidates who receive allotment should have attained the eligibility for admission as per Clause 9 of the Prospectus at the time of admission. The candidates who get allotment in this phase shall have to join the allotted college within the stipulated time. (Detailed schedule regarding the joining will be notified later). Candidates who get allotment shall have to pay the amount shown in the allotment memo in the allotted colleges at the time of admission.

Option Registration Fee (for candidates who have not already paid option registration fee in the first phase allotment)

Those candidates who wish to register options will have to remit registration fees of Rs.2000/- (Rupees Two Thousand only) to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations. Candidates belonging to SC/ST/OEC category, candidates eligible for benefits as per G.O (Ms) No. 25/2005/SCSTDD, dated: 20.06.2005 and G.O (Ms) No.10/2014/ BCDD, dated: 23.05.2014 and those candidates from Juvenile Home, Nirbhaya Home, Sreechithra Home need to remit Rs.500/- (Rupees Five Hundred Only) only as Registration Fee. Registration fees have to be remitted by way of online payment. The registration fee of those candidates who do not get allotment will be refunded. If a candidate gets allotment and does not join within the stipulated time, the option registration fee will be considered as penalty and will not be refunded. Option registration fee of the candidates who quit the seat after taking admission will be considered as penalty and will not be refunded. Refund of option registration fee for the eligible candidates will be made only after the completion of allotment process and the schedule for the same will be notified.

Fee Concession:

Candidates belonging to SC/ST/OEC/Communities eligible for educational

concessions as is given to OEC/Candidates eligible for fee concession as per GO(Ms)No.25/2005/SCSTDD dated: 20.06.2005/Children of Fisherman/Inmates of Sri Chitra Home, Nirbhaya home & Juvenile home allotted under Government Quota are exempted from payment of fees.

Candidates who receive allotment should have attained the eligibility for admission as per Clause 9 of the Prospectus at the time of admission.

Important

1. Candidates who do not take admission within the specified dates shall lose their allotment.
2. Candidates who receive a change of allotment to their higher options in the second phase of allotment will automatically lose their current admission and hence they should obtain the T.C, relevant documents and amount remitted at the time of admission from their currently admitted college and join the newly allotted colleges as per the schedule specified in the allotment memo.
3. Candidates are advised not to retain unnecessary options to courses/colleges where they do not wish to join, if allotted.
4. Allotment shall be subject to the final order/affiliation/approval of the Govt./University concerned.
