LLM COURSE-2024
VACANT SEAT ALLOTMENT - FRESH OPTIONS INVITED

The activities related to the Vacant Seat allotment to fill up the vacant seats that exist/arise after the second phase of centralized allotment for admission to LLM Course in the Government Law Colleges and Private Self- financing Law Colleges for the year 2024-25 commences on 19.12.2024.

Candidates who have figured in the rank list of LLM Course 2024 published by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations and satisfy the eligibility criteria as per clause 9 in the Prospectus can register fresh options and participate in this phase of allotment.

The schedule for the allotment is given below:

19.12.2024	Option Registration starts
23.12.2024, 01.00 PM	Option Registration ends
Allotment and Institution Joining Schedule will be notified later	

The candidates who get allotment in this phase shall have to join the allotted college with all the original certificates as given in the prospectus clause 19 within the stipulated time to be announced by the Commissioner for Entrance and should remit applicable tuition fee, other fees and the deposits (if applicable) to the allotted colleges at the time of admission.

General Rules of Vacant Seat Allotment:

1. If no seat is allotted to the candidate in the vacant seat allotment, the existing admission, if any, shall prevail, and if a seat is allotted to the candidate in the vacant seat allotment, the existing admission, if any, will stand cancelled and the candidate shall have to accept the new allotment.
2. Probable vacancies arising due to the up-gradations to higher options or category conversions will also be filled up in the vacant seat allotment based on the options for the vacant seat allotment, hence candidates are advised to take into account probable vacancies also in addition to the real vacancies available at the start of the vacant seat allotment process.
3. The seats received through vacant seat allotment cannot be changed further at any instance.
4. Candidates who are allotted a seat in the vacant seat allotment (irrespective of the admission status) will not be eligible for any subsequent allotments.
5. After the Vacant Seat Allotment, if vacancies exist/arise, these vacancies shall be filled through Stray Vacancy Filling Allotments. Stray Vacancy Filling Allotments, if any conducted, will have fresh option registration opportunity. But already admitted candidates will not be considered for stray vacancy filling rounds. Notification regarding the same will be issued later and the decision of Commissioner for Entrance examination is Final in this regard.
6. Candidates already admitted to the course through previous phases of allotment conducted by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, get an allotment through the Vacant Seat Allotment, current admission of the candidate will stand cancelled. Hence candidates should register options to only those colleges where they want to study for the course if they get an allotment.
7. Allotments shall be subject to the final order/affiliation/approval of the Government/University concerned.

Registration Fees

Those candidates who wish to register options for the vacant seat allotments will have to pay separate registration fees to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.

Those candidates who wish to register options will have to remit registration fees of Rs.2000/- (Rupees Two Thousand only) to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations. Candidates belonging to SC/ST/OEC category, candidate eligible for benefits as per G.O (Ms) No. 25/2005/SCSTDD, dated: 20.06.2005 and G.O (Ms) No.10/2014/ BCDD, dated: 23.05.2014 and those candidates from Juvenile Home, Nirbhaya Home, Sreechithra Home will have to remit Rs.500/- (Rupees Five Hundred Only) as Registration Fee. Registration fee has to be remitted by way of online payment. The registration fee of those candidates who do not get allotment will be refunded. If a candidate gets allotment and does not join within the stipulated time, the option registration fee will be forfeited as penalty and hence will not be refunded. Option registration fee of the candidates who quit the seats after taking admission will also be forfeited as penalty and hence will not be refunded. Refund of option registration fee for the eligible candidates will be made only after the completion of allotment process and it will be notified.

Candidates admitted to the course through previous phases of allotment by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations can avail free exit from the course on or before **23.12.2024, 12:00 PM**. Candidates shall be liable for penalty if they vacate seats or obtain T.C after **23.12.2024, 12:00 PM**.
