SECOND ROUND STRAY VACANCY ALLOTMENT
OPTIONS INVITED

The activities related to the Second Round Stray Vacancy Allotment to fill up the vacant seats that exist/arise after the first round stray vacancy allotment for admission to LLM Course in the Government Law Colleges and Private Self- financing Law Colleges for the year 2024-25 has commenced.

The schedule for the allotment is given below:

08.01.2025	Option Registration starts
10.01.2025, 02:00 PM	Option Registration ends
Allotment and Institution Joining Schedule will be notified later	

The candidates who get allotment in this phase shall have to join the allotted college with all the original certificates as given in the prospectus clause 19 within the stipulated time to be announced by the Commissioner for Entrance and should remit applicable tuition fee, other fees and the deposits (if applicable) in the allotted colleges at the time of admission.

General Rules of Stray Vacancy Allotment:

Based on the following conditions, Candidates who have figured in the rank list of LLM Course 2024 published by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations and satisfy the eligibility criteria as per clause 9 in the Prospectus can register fresh options and participate in this phase of allotment.

1. Those who have already been admitted will not be eligible to participate in this phase and subsequent phases of allotments.
2. Those who have got allotment in vacant seat allotment/ first round stray vacancy allotment will not be eligible to participate in this phase and subsequent phases of allotments.
3. Probable vacancies due to category conversions will also be filled up in the second round stray vacancy allotment based on the options in this stray vacancy allotment, hence candidates are advised to take into account probable vacancies also.
4. The seats received through second round stray vacancy allotment cannot be changed further at any instance.
5. Candidates who are allotted a seat in the second round stray vacancy allotment (irrespective of the admission status) will not be eligible for any subsequent allotments.
6. After the second round Stray Vacancy Allotment, if vacancies exist/arise, these vacancies shall be filled through college level stray Vacancy Allotment. For college level stray vacancy allotment, options registered by candidates during this round of the Stray Vacancy Allotments will be considered. Detailed notification will be issued later.
7. Allotment shall be subject to the final order/affiliation/approval of the Government/University concerned.

Vacancy after First round stray vacancy allotment has been published. Candidates can check the list in the official website of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, www.cee.kerala.gov.in.

Registration Fees

Those candidates who paid the option registration fee in the vacant seat allotment or the First round stray vacancy allotment but were not allotted a seat in the vacant seat allotment or First round stray vacancy allotment, as the case may be, do not have to pay the option registration fee again in this round.

All other eligible candidates who wish to register options in second round stray vacancy allotment will have to pay the option registration fees to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.

Those candidates who wish to register options will have to remit registration fees of Rs.2000/- (Rupees Two Thousand only) to the

Commissioner for Entrance Examinations. Candidates belonging to SC/ST/OEC category eligible for benefits as per G.O (Ms) No. 25/2005/SCSTDD, dated: 20.06.2005 and G.O (Ms) No.10/2014/ BCDD, dated: 23.05.2014 and those candidates from Juvenile Home, Nirbhaya Home, Sreechithra Home will have to remit Rs.500/- (Rupees Five Hundred Only) as Registration Fee. Registration fee has to be remitted by way of online payment. The registration fee of those candidates who do not get allotment will be refunded. If a candidate gets allotment and does not join within the stipulated time, the option registration fee will be considered as penalty and will not be refunded. Option registration fee of the candidates who quit the seats after taking admission will be considered as penalty and will not be refunded. Refund of option registration fee for the eligible candidates will be made only after the completion of allotment process and it will be notified.
