### **ENTRANCE EXAMINATION FOR ADMISSION TO** **LLM COURSE-2025** **APPLICATION INVITED**

Applications are invited for the Computer Based Entrance Examination for admission to L.L.M Course 2025-26 in Government Law Colleges at Thiruvananthapuram, Ernakulam, Thrissur and Kozhikode and in Private Self Financing Law Colleges in the State which have entered into seat sharing agreement with the State Government.

#### **1. Eligibility for Admission:**

- i. **Nativity:** Applicant should be an Indian citizen. However, only those candidates who are of Kerala origin are eligible for any type of reservation or any fee concession. [See clause 9(i) of the Prospectus].
- ii. **Academic qualifications:** Candidates who have passed the L.L.B. examination (Five year / Three year course) with a minimum of 50% marks from any University in Kerala or any other Universities, recognized by the particular University in Kerala to which the college that the candidate desires to get admitted is affiliated, as equivalent there to.
- iii. **Age:** There is no upper age limit for admission to the L.L.M Course.

#### **2. Online Entrance Examination:**

The Online Entrance Examination (Computer Based Test) will be conducted at Thiruvananthapuram, Ernakulam and Kozhikkode centres. Detailed time schedule of the examination will be notified later. Questions will be of two parts of a total of 2 hours duration. Each part will consist of 100 Objective

type questions. The questions will be of the standard of L.L.B Course .

### **3. Submission of Online Application and Application Fee:**

The application fee is Rs.900/- (Rupees Nine Hundred only ) for General and SEBC candidates and Rs.450/- (Rupees Four Hundred and Fifty only) for SC/ST candidates. Candidates seeking admission to the course can apply online through the website **www.cee.kerala.gov.in** of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations till **10.07.2025, 5.00 PM** and should remit the required application fee within the date by way of online payment. Net Banking/Debit Card/Credit Card facility can be used for Online Payment. The candidate who has remitted the fee successfully should upload recent passport size colour photograph/ signature, communal reservation, special reservation, EWS, Income Certificate for fee concession, if applicable, within the above mentioned date.

No need to send the printout of the application to the office of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.

### **Certificates/Documents to be uploaded to the Online Application (PDF format from 10 kb to 500 kb)**

- Nationality proof : Any one of the documents mentioned under clause 9 (i)
- Nativity Proof: Any one of the documents mentioned under clause 9(i)
- Certificate to prove age: relevant page of SSLC/Birth Certificate/Passport.
- Community certificate obtained from Tahsildar in the case of SC/ST candidates.
- Non-Creamy Layer Certificate (**for State Education purpose only**) in the prescribed format/e-district from the Village Officer concerned in the case of SEBC/OEC candidates.
- The candidates eligible for EWS Quota seats should submit the EWS Certificate from the concerned Village Officer. (Annexure VII(a), (b) of the prospectus).
- Community Certificate from the Village Officer concerned in the case of OEC candidates who do not come under Non-Creamy layer category.
- Non-Creamy Layer/Community and Income Certificates from the

Village officer concerned in the prescribed format in the case of candidates belonging to the communities listed in Annexure IV (b).

- Inter-Caste marriage certificate: Candidates who are children of Inter-Caste married couple of whom one is SC/ST, need to upload Inter-Caste marriage Certificate issued by Tahsildar.
- Valid certificate from the District Medical Board for Persons with Disabilities (if applicable).
- Certificate from the Fisheries Officer concerned of Kerala Fishermen Welfare Fund Board for fee concession in the case of candidates who are the children of registered Fishermen.
- Certificate from the Director, Department of Women & Child Development for fee concession in the case of candidates who are inmates of Sri Chitra Home, Nirbhaya Home, Juvenile Home or any other such institution run by the Government.
- Any other documents mentioned in the Notification of the Entrance Examination and Centralized /vacant seat filling allotments.

4. Candidates will not be allowed to include any additional information in the online application form or to submit any certificate/document claiming reservation or any benefits, after the online submission of the application, under any circumstances. Applications in this regard or any such documents will not be accepted in the Office of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.

5. Certificates submitted should be in the prescribed format available in the website or in the e-district format.

6. The candidates applied for the online entrance examination can download their **Admit Card** from the website **www.cee.kerala.gov.in** from the date to be announced later. The admit card thus obtained should be brought to the examination hall.

**7. Allotment of Seats:** The institution-wise allotment will be conducted by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations in accordance with the ranks obtained by the candidates in the Entrance Examination (as per clause 18 of the prospectus) and the order of preference of institutions registered by the candidates during Online Centralized Allotment Process (CAP). Intimations regarding the Entrance Examinations and CAP will be notified on the website and in leading newspapers. Individual intimation in this regard will not be sent to candidates.

The Entrance Examination and subsequent allotments will be based on the provisions laid down in the Prospectus for Admission to LL.M Course, Kerala 2025- 26, available in the website [www.cee.kerala.gov.in](http://www.cee.kerala.gov.in). Candidates are advised to read the Prospectus before submitting their applications.
