16: Centralized Allotment Process (CAP) and Online Submission of Options:-

The Centralized Allotment Process (CAP) will be done online to give allotment to the Dental PG Courses under General and Se rvice category. Candidates will be allowed to exercise their option for individual speci alities/colleges as per their ranks. The allo tment of courses/colleges for the General Merit and reservation categories will be st rictly in accordance with the rank list and category lists mentioned in clause 15 abov e.

The Commissioner for Entrance Exami nations (CEE) will carry out a Centralized Allotment Process (CAP) of under State system. Centralized Allotment Process (CAP) will be done online to give allotments to the Medical PG Dental courses under General & Reservation seats as per claus e 15 of the prospectus.

There will be three phases of online counselingie; Phase1, Phase 2 and Mop up round.

## Phase 1

Eligible candidates, who are included in the State rank list (Kerala Merit list and Servic e Quota rank list) prepared by the CEE c an register fresh options during the first ph

16: Centralized Allotment Process (CAP) and Online Submission of Options:-

The Centralized Allotment Process (CAP) will be done online to give allotment to the Dental PG Courses under General and Service category. Candidates will be allowed to exercise their option for individual specialities/colleges as per their ranks. The allotment of courses/colleges for the General Merit and reservation categories will be strictly in accordance with the rank list and category lists mentioned in clause 15 above.

The Commissioner for Entrance Examination s (CEE) will carry out a Centralized Allotment P rocess (CAP) of under State system. Centralized Allotment Process (CAP) will be done online to give allotments to the Medical PG Dental courses under General & Reservation seats as per clause 15 of the prospectus.

There will be three phases of online counselling i e; Round 1, Round 2 and Round 3 round.

#### Round 1

Eligible candidates, who are included in the State rank list (Kerala Merit list and Service Qu ota rank list) prepared by the CEE can registe r fresh options during the first round counseling, based on which and based on rank and categ ory, allotment will be published. A Security deposit of Rs.10,000 will have to be paid at the tim

ase counseling, based on which and based on rank and category, allotment will be published. A Security deposit of Rs.10,000 will have to be paid at the time of option regis tration. For SC/ST/OE and other candidate s who are eligible for fee concession, Rs.5 000/- will have to be paid as Security deposit.

#### Phase 2

In the second phase counseling, there is n o facility for fresh option registration for th e candidates. Only option confirmation /del etion/re- arrangement of the existing option s in Phase 2 is possible. Option confirmatio n is compulsory to participate in Phase 2. Option registration will be available only if any new course is added to the list at this stage. If a candidate is allotted a seat in the e first round and joined the allotted seat, hi s/her higher options will be retained and all those options listed below the allotted opti on will automatically be deleted thus enabli ng only upgradation/retention in the same s eat. If a candidate joined in a seat in Phas e 1 does not give confirmation of option in the Phase 2 he will not be considered for upgradation in Phase 2, but the seat joined in Phase 1 will be retained. So if a candida te joined in Phase 1 does not want upgrad ation in Phase 2, he/she may not confirm o ptions or delete all options registered.

## Round 2

In the second round counseling, there is no faci lity for fresh option registration for the candidat es. Only option confirmation/deletion/re-arrange ment of the existing options in round 2 is possi ble. Option confirmation is compulsory to partici pate in round 2. Option registration will be avail able only if any new course is added to the list at this stage. If a candidate is allotted a seat i n the first round and joined the allotted seat, hi s/her higher options will be retained and all tho se options listed below the allotted option will a utomatically be deleted thus enabling only upgr adation/retention in the same seat. If a candid ate joined in a seat in round 1 does not give co nfirmation of option in the round 2 he will not b e considered for upgradation in round 2, but th e seat joined in round 1 will be retained. So if a candidate joined in round 1 does not want upgr adation in round 2, he/she may not confirm opti ons or delete all options registered.

Free exit condition: Those candidates who wish to vacate the seats joined through Round 1 / R ound 2 can exit the seat on or before the dat e notified by the CEE. But such candidates will not be considered for further rounds of centrali sed allotment process except in Stray vacancy allotment.

After the first two rounds of counseling, M op up counseling will start, which also offer s fresh option registration to candidates. T he net vacant seats due to Un-allotted/ No n joining of Round 2 will be published. Can didates shall register options to any seats they wish to join if allotted irrespective of the vacancy status notified as any vacanc y that may arise during the counselling will be filled based on these options. As applic able category conversions of seats will tak e place in the mop-up allotment, while regis tering options for the mop-up allotment can didates are advised to take into account th ose probable vacancies too that may arise due to the applicable category conversion rules. The options registered in this Mop-up phase will be considered for Stray vacancy seat filling also.

Penalty Conditions in Mop-up Phase:

From the Mop up phase onwards, restriction has been implemented to candidates in order to avoid lapsing of seats and holding of AIQ seats and State quota seats thus blocking seats. Hence candidates are advi

#### Round 3

After the first two rounds of counseling, Third allotment will start. There is no facility for fresh option registration for the candidates. Only opti on confirmation/deletion/rearrangement of the e xisting options in Phase 3 is possible. Option c onfirmation is compulsory to participate in Phas e 3. Option registration will be available only if any new course is added to the list at this sta ge. If a candidate is allotted a seat in the seco nd round and joined the allotted seat, his/her hi gher options will be retained and all those optio ns listed below the allotted option will automati cally be deleted thus enabling only up gradation /retention in the same seat. If a candidate joine d in a seat in Phase 2 does not give confirmati on of option in the Phase 3 he will not be consi dered for up gradation in Phase 3, but the seat joined in Phase 2 will be retained. So if a candi date joined in Phase 2 does not want up grad ation in Phase 3, he/she may not confirm option ns or after confirmation delete all options regist

Candidates who will be excluded in 3<sup>rd</sup> Allotment:

- A candidate who was allotted a se at in Phase 2 of State counseling b ut did not join the allotted seat
- A candidate who joined the allotted seat in Phase 2 of State counseling but after that vacated the seat.
- Those candidates who are allotted seats through All India 3<sup>rd</sup> round allo tment.

Penalty Conditions in 3<sup>rd</sup> round :

sed to exercise due diligence in exercising their options and do not file unwanted options to seats in which they do not wish to pursue studies. As a measure to prevent this, a separate Registration fee will be implemented to all candidates, who register freshoptions in Mop up Phase.

- Registration fee amounting to the annual tuition fee of the seat opted, if opted only for Government seat or an amount of Rs.1,00,000 (Rupees One lakhs only) if opted also for a seat in Private Self financing Medical College may be set as registration fee. For SC/ST/OE and other candidates who are eligible for fee concession, the registration fee for Govt. /Pvt.medical college seats will be half of the above amounts respectively.
- The registration fee paid for Mop-up allo tment will be adjusted in the fee of the c ourse, if the candidate gets an allotment or else will be refunded after the end of counselling.
- The registration fee paid for Mop-up pha se of those candidates who do not join t he seat allotted in Mop-up or stray vaca ncy filling allotment will be treated as pe nalty and will not be refunded.

From the 3<sup>rd</sup> round onwards, restriction has be en implemented to candidates in order to avoid lapsing of seats and holding of AIQ seats and State quota seats thus blocking seats. A candidate allotted a seat in 3<sup>rd</sup> round in State couns eling shall be ineligible to participate in any furth er counseling.

Hence candidates are advised to exercise due diligence in exercising their options and do not file unwanted options to seats in which they do not wish to pursue studies. The list of candidat es admitted as on the last date of admission in Phase 3 will be forwarded to MCC as the list of candidates ineligible to participate in any furt her rounds of All India or State counseling. Tho se candidates who vacate seat (allotted in Round 1 or Round 2 or Round 3), after the last date of joining of Round 3 will not be considered for further rounds of counseling.

e options registered by the candidates during the Mop up round will be considered. If vacancies exist even after an initial stray vacancy allotment and if there is sufficient time before the cut-off date for admissions prescribed by Dental Council of India, additional stray vacancy allotments may be conducted and finally list of eligible candidates shall be forwarded to the Colleges where vacancies exist and the allotment shall be done at the College level based on guidelines issued by CEE at the time.

The various lists of candidates for the coll ege level stray vacancy filling after the mo p-up allotment will be prepared based on the options registered for the mop-up allotment process. So, candidates who intend to participate in the institution level stray vacancy filling should participate in the mop-up allotment also by registering fresh options for the mop-up allotment.

- Candidates who have obtained admission in the 1<sup>st</sup>& 2 nd phase allotment in Kerala a Government merit seats for an MDS course in any of the Govt. Dental Colleges shall eligible to participate in the Mop up Counseling for the same subject in other Govt./Self financing Dental Colleges.
- Candidates who have obtained admission in the 1<sup>st</sup>& 2 nd phase allotment in Gove rnment merit seats for a course in any of the Self Financing Dental Colleges shall be eligible to participate in the Mop Up Counseling for the same subject in other Self Financing/Govt. Dental Colleges.
- Any vacancy that may aris e after the cut-off date for admissions prescribed by t he Government of India/Su preme Court will be consid ered as lapsed and no allo tment/transfer will be made to these seats under any circumstances.
- No allotment/transfer to PG Dental courses will be done under any circumstance after the last date of admission pr escribed by the Government of India/Supreme Court.

- Changes, if any effected by the Hon'ble Supreme Court/DGHS, New Delhi, in th e time schedule for admissio n process will be applicable f or the State Quota seats in Self Financing Dental College s also.
- Additional Service candidate seats, if any, sanctioned duri ng the validity of the rank list will be filled up in the final C AP.
- Any vacancy that may arise after the cut- off date for ad missions prescribed by the Government of India / Hon'bl e Supreme Court will be con sidered as lapsed and no all otment / transfer will be mad e to these seats under any circumstances.
- No allotment /transfer / Surre nder / Exchange to P.G.Dent al Courses-2023 will be done under any circumstance after the last date of admission pr escribed by the Government of India / Hon'ble Supreme C ourt.
- Changes, if any effected by the Hon'ble Supreme of India /Director General of Health S ervices, New Delhi, in the tim e schedule for admission pro cess will be applicable for St ate Quota seats in Self Fina ncing Dental Colleges also.

The various lists of candidates for the stray vaca ncy filling will be prepared by the CE E based on the options registered b y the candidates for the mop-up allot ment process. So, candidates who in tend to participate in the institution le vel stray vacancy filling should participate in the mop-up allotment also by registering fresh options for the mop-up allotment.

cancies that may exist after the completion of the admission process of the 3 rd round allotment will be filled up through an institution level stray vacancy filling procedure. The various lists of candidates for the stray vacancy filling will be prepared by the CEE based on the options registered by the candidate s. So, candidates who intend to participate in the institution level stray vacancy filling should participate in the 3 rd round allotment.

# 18.1.1 Conversion of seats (Ne w clause Added)

The conversion of seats if any will be c arried out during the processing of opti ons for the stray vacancy allotment. If any category seat remains vacant due to insufficient number of options to fill u p the vacant seats even after fresh op tions are registered for the stray vacan cy allotment, the applicable category c onversion will be carried out as part of the stray vacancy allotment process. T he conversion will be effected even if t here are candidates of the category in the rank list but have failed to give opti ons to the category seat in stray vaca ncy allotment. Such conversion will be done during the stray vacancy allotmen t process and allotment will be done to the new category arrived at by conver sion. Any claim for the seat after effect ing seat conversion and allotment to the e converted category in stray vacancy allotment due to absence of options of eligible candidates belonging to the original category will not be considered.
