- Phase 2

In the second phase counseling, there is no facility for fresh option registration for the candidates. Only option confirmation /deletion/re- arrangement of the existing options in Phase 2 is possible. Option confirmation is compulsory to participate in Phase 2. Option registration will be available only if any new course is added to the list at this stage. If a candidate is allotted a seat in the first round and joined the allotted seat, his/her higher options will be retained and all those options listed below the allotted option will automatically be deleted thus enabling only upgradation/retention in the same seat. If a candidate joined in a seat in Phase 1 does not give confirmation of option in the Phase 2 he will not be considered for upgradation in Phase 2, but the seat joined in Phase 1 will be retained. So if a candidate joined in Phase 1 does not want upgradation in Phase 2, he/she may not confirm options or delete all options registered.

- Round 2

In the second round counseling, there is no facility for fresh option registration for the candidates. Only option confirmation/deletion/re-arrangement of the existing options in round 2 is possible. Option confirmation is compulsory to participate in round 2. Option registration will be available only if any new course is added to the list at this stage. If a candidate is allotted a seat in the first round and joined the allotted seat, his/her higher options will be retained and all those options listed below the allotted option will automatically be deleted thus enabling only upgradation/retention in the same seat. If a candidate joined in a seat in round 1 does not give confirmation of option in the round 2 he will not be considered for upgradation in round 2, but the seat joined in round 1 will be retained. So if a candidate joined in round 1 does not want upgradation in round 2, he/she may not confirm options or delete all options registered.

Free exit condition: Those candidates who wish to vacate the seats joined through Round 1 / Round 2 can exit the seat on or before the date notified by the CEE. But such candidates will not be considered for further rounds of centralised allotment process except in Stray vacancy allotment.

After the first two rounds of counseling, Mop up counseling will start, which also offers fresh option registration to candidates. The net vacant seats due to Un-allotted/ Non joining of Round 2 will be published. Candidates shall register options to any seats they wish to join if allotted irrespective of the vacancy status notified as any vacancy that may arise during the counselling will be filled based on these options. As applicable category conversions of seats will take place in the mop-up allotment, while registering options for the mop-up allotment candidates are advised to take into account those probable vacancies too that may arise due to the applicable category conversion rules. The options registered in this Mop-up phase will be considered for Stray vacancy seat filling also.

- Penalty Conditions in Mop-up Phase:

From the Mop up phase onwards, restriction has been implemented to candidates in order to avoid lapsing of seats and holding of AIQ seats and State quota seats thus blocking seats. Hence candidates are advised

- Round 3

After the first two rounds of counseling, Third allotment will start. There is no facility for fresh option registration for the candidates. Only option confirmation/deletion/rearrangement of the existing options in Phase 3 is possible. Option confirmation is compulsory to participate in Phase 3. Option registration will be available only if any new course is added to the list at this stage. If a candidate is allotted a seat in the second round and joined the allotted seat, his/her higher options will be retained and all those options listed below the allotted option will automatically be deleted thus enabling only up gradation/retention in the same seat. If a candidate joined in a seat in Phase 2 does not give confirmation of option in the Phase 3 he will not be considered for up gradation in Phase 3, but the seat joined in Phase 2 will be retained. So if a candidate joined in Phase 2 does not want up gradation in Phase 3, he/she may not confirm options or after confirmation delete all options registered.

Candidates who will be excluded in 3rd Allotment:

- A candidate who was allotted a seat in Phase 2 of State counseling but did not join the allotted seat
- A candidate who joined the allotted seat in Phase 2 of State counseling but after that vacated the seat.
- Those candidates who are allotted seats through All India 3rd round allotment.

Penalty Conditions in 3rd round :

sed to exercise due diligence in exercising their options and do not file unwanted options to seats in which they do not wish to pursue studies. As a measure to prevent this, a separate Registration fee will be implemented to all candidates, who register fresh options in Mop up Phase.

- Registration fee amounting to the annual tuition fee of the seat opted, if opted only for Government seat or an amount of Rs.1,00,000 (Rupees One lakhs only) if opted also for a seat in Private Self financing Medical College may be set as registration fee. For SC/ST/OE and other candidates who are eligible for fee concession, the registration fee for Govt. /Private medical college seats will be half of the above amounts respectively.
- The registration fee paid for Mop-up allotment will be adjusted in the fee of the course, if the candidate gets an allotment or else will be refunded after the end of counselling.
- The registration fee paid for Mop-up phase of those candidates who do not join the seat allotted in Mop-up or stray vacancy filling allotment will be treated as penalty and will not be refunded.

- Stray Vacancy Filling Phase

After the Mop up allotment, if any vacancies exist or arise, those vacancies shall be filled through Stray vacancy allotment. This may be conducted in online or offline mode and will be decided upon by the CEE at the time. For the Stray vacancy allotment, th

A candidate allotted a seat in 3rd round in State counseling shall be ineligible to participate in any further counseling.

Hence candidates are advised to exercise due diligence in exercising their options and do not file unwanted options to seats in which they do not wish to pursue studies. The list of candidates admitted as on the last date of admission in Phase 3 will be forwarded to MCC as the list of candidates ineligible to participate in any further rounds of All India or State counseling. Those candidates who vacate seat (allotted in Round 1 or Round 2 or Round 3), after the last date of joining of Round 3 will not be considered for further rounds of counseling.

- Stray Vacancy Filling Phase

If any category seat remains vacant due to insufficient number of options to fill up the vacant seats even after fresh options are registered for the stray vacancy allotment, the applicable category conversion will be carried out as part of the stray vacancy allotment process. The conversion will be effected even if there are candidates of the category in the rank list but have failed to give options to the category seat in stray vacancy allotment. Such conversion will be done during the stray vacancy allotment process and allotment will be done to the new category arrived at by conversion. Any claim for the seat after effecting seat conversion and allotment to the converted category in stray vacancy allotment due to absence of options of eligible candidates belonging to the original category will not be considered.</p>
