THIRD ROUND ALLOTMENT TO PG DENTAL (DEGREE)
COURSES, KERALA-2023
ONLINE OPTION CONFIRMATION FACILITY AVAILABLE

The activities related to the Third Round Allotment to Post Graduate Dental courses 2023 in Government Dental Colleges and Private Self-financing Dental Colleges in the state have commenced. This allotment will be conducted to fill up the currently available vacant seats and the seats expected to be released during the allotment process of the third round. Eligible candidates included in the Rank list published by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations confirm their options online through the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in up to **21.09.2023, 3.00 PM**.

Candidates may enter their Application Number and password in the link '**PG Dental 2023 Candidate Portal**' provided on the above website to log on to their home page. Then by clicking the menu '**Confirmation**' candidates can confirm their options online. The allotment will be based on the rank list and the online options received up to **3:00 PM on 21.09.2023**. Candidates who get an allotment in the third phase of counseling will lose their current admission based on previous allotments. Candidates who get allotment shall have to join the allotted colleges by paying the fees to the allotted college.

Online Option Confirmation is mandatory:

There is no facility for fresh option registration for the candidates in this phase. Only option confirmation/deletion/re-arrangement of the existing options in phase 3 is possible. Option confirmation is compulsory to participate in phase 3. If a candidate was allotted a seat in the 2nd phase and has joined the allotted seats, his/her higher options will be retained and all those options listed below the allotted options will automatically be deleted

thus enabling only upgradation/retention in the same seats. If a candidate who joined in a seat in phase 2 does not give confirmation of option in phase 3 he will not be considered for upgradation in phase 3, but the seat joined in phase 2 will be retained. So, if a candidate who joined in phase 2 does not want upgradation in phase 3, he/she may not confirm options or after confirmation delete all options registered. Those who do not confirm their options online will not be considered for the third phase of allotment for the existing options.

Tentative schedule for the allotment is given below

17.09.2023	Website opens for Option Confirmation/Rearrangement/ Deletion.
21.09.2023, 3.00 PM	Time for Option Confirmation/Rearrangement/ Deletion ends
27.09.2023	Publication of Third Phase Allotment
28.09.2023 to 30.09.2023, 4.00 PM	All candidates who get an allotment should join the course and college to which they are allotted along with the required documents and pay the fee at the colleges.
30.09.2023, 5.00 PM	College authorities shall have to approve and submit the list of admitted candidates to the CEE through the OAMS.

Candidates who will be excluded in the 3rd phase allotment:

- 1) Candidates who were allotted a seat in phase 2 of State counseling, but did not join the allotted seat.
- 2) A candidate who joined the allotted seat in phase 2 of State counseling, but vacated the seat.
- 3) Data will be shared with the MCC and the state after the third phase allotment/admission and if any candidate has his name in the list of candidates shared by the MCC, then such candidates will become ineligible for participating in the third phase.

From the 3rd phase onwards, the restriction has been implemented for candidates in order to avoid lapsing of seats and holding of AIQ and State Quota Seats thus blocking seats. A candidate allotted a seat in 3rd phase in State Counseling shall not be eligible to participate in any further Counseling. Hence, candidates are advised to exercise due diligence in

confirming their options and not retain unwanted options to seats in which they do not wish to pursue studies. The list of candidates allotted/admitted as on the last date of admission in phase 3 will be forwarded to MCC as the lists of candidates ineligible to participate in any further rounds of All India or State Counseling.

If any candidates (including SC/ST/OEC Students) discontinue the PG Dental course after joining the third round of counseling shall have to pay liquidated damages as per prospectus clause 19.5. If a service candidate discontinues the PG Dental course after the third round of counseling shall have to pay liquidated damages as per clause 11.5.

Stray Vacancy Filling:

After the 3rd phase allotment, if vacancies exist or arise, those vacancies shall be filled through stray vacancy allotment. The Stray Vacancy Allotment offers fresh option registration to candidates.

- There will be fresh option registration for stray vacancy filling. Hence a candidate wishing to participate in stray vacancy filling shall have to exit the seats on or before 24.09.2023, 12.00 Noon. Candidates who exit the seat after 24.09.2023, 12.00 Noon are not eligible for participating in further rounds of allotment including the stray vacancy filling.
- Data will be shared with the MCC and the state after the third phase allotment and if any candidate has his name in the list of allotted/admitted candidates in MCC or state, then such candidate shall not be eligible for participating in the stray vacancy filling.
- Candidates who joined the allotted seat in the third phase allotment are not eligible for participating in the stray vacancy filling.
- Candidates who have been allotted seats in the third phase are not eligible to participate in the stray vacancy filling.
- Candidates who joined/holding a seat in the all India quota/Deemed/Central University seats at the time of stray vacancy filling as per the data shared by the central authorities are not eligible for participating in stray vacancy filling.
