ADMISSION TO PG DENTAL COURSES-2024 FIRST PHASE CENTRALISED ALLOTMENT PUBLISHED

The first phase of Centralised allotment to PG Dental Courses for the academic year 2024-25 in the Government Dental Colleges and Private Self Financing Dental colleges in the State is published in the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in. The allotment is based on the rank in the Kerala State merit list published by Commissioner for Entrance Examinations and online options filed by the candidates from 16.07.2024 to 19.07.2024, 11.59 PM. The allotment has been published after addressing the valid complaints received from candidates against the provisional allotment published on 21.07.2024. The allotment result is available in the website of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations www.cee.kerala.gov.in.

To view the allotment result, candidates should log on the 'PG Dental 2024-candidate portal' by submitting their Application Number and Password. y clicking on the link 'Allotment Result', candidates can view their allotment result. The Allotment Memo will be available in the above link from 22.07.2024 onwards. It is necessary to take a printout of the Allotment memo. Those candidates who receive an allotment shall have to remit the fees as specified in the first phase allotment memo.

The allotted candidates should report for joining the allotted colleges from 22.07.2024 to 25.07.2024, 4.00 PM along with the required documents (as per Prospectus Clause 13) specified in the allotment memo. The fee, should be remitted at the allotted college during admission. The fee as shown for courses in Self-Financing Dental Colleges is strictly provisional and candidates are liable to pay the fee at the revised rate as and when the fee for the academic year 2024-25 is fixed by Admission Supervisory Committee/Government/Hon'ble Court. The allotted candidates who do not take admission in the respective colleges within the stipulated time and

those candidates who quit the seats after taking admission will lose his/her present allotment as well as all the higher order options and will not be considered for phase 2 allotments. The registration fee of those candidates who do not join within the stipulated time after getting the allotment and those candidates who quit the seats after taking admission will be considered as penalty and will not be refunded. In the second phase counseling, there is no facility for fresh option registration for the candidates. Only option confirmation /deletion/re- arrangement of the existing options is possible. Option confirmation is compulsory to participate in Round 2. Option registration will be available only if any new course is added to the list at this stage.

Those NRI candidates, who have uploaded sworn affidavit from the Sponsor for VISA validity extension have to clear the defects on or before the last date fixed by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations for option registration for the third phase allotment to PG Dental courses, by uploading relevant documents for clearing the Memo. Those candidates who fail to upload the documents as specified within the time limit fixed by Commissioner for Entrance Examinations will lose the allotment, if any, received under NRI quota in this phase and the Provisional NRI quota claim of the candidate will also stand cancelled. Any allotment received in NRI quota by such candidates in this phase will be treated as provisional.

All the college authorities should approve the list of admitted candidates through Online Admission Management System (OAMS) by **6.00 PM on 25.07.2024.**
