FIRST PHASE CENTRALISED ALLOTMENT PUBLISHED

The first phase of Centralised allotment to PG Dental Courses for the academic year 2026-27 in the Government Dental Colleges and Private Self Financing Dental colleges in the State is published in the website **www.cee.kerala.gov.in**. The allotment is based on the rank in the Kerala State merit list published by Commissioner for Entrance Examinations and online options filed by the candidates from **22.08.2026 to 03.09.2026, 11:00 AM**. The allotment has been published after addressing the valid complaints received from candidates against the provisional allotment published on **04.09.2026**. The allotment result is available in the website of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations **www.cee.kerala.gov.in**.

To view the allotment result, candidates should log on the '**PG Dental 2026-candidate portal**' by submitting their Application Number and Password. By clicking on the link '**Allotment Result**', candidates can view their allotment result. The Allotment Memo will be available in the above link from **05.09.2026** onwards. It is necessary to take a printout of the Allotment memo. Those candidates who receive an allotment shall have to remit the fees as specified in the first phase allotment memo.

The allotted candidates should report for joining the allotted colleges from **07.09.2026 to 11.09.2026, 4:00 PM** along with the required documents (as per Prospectus Clause 13) specified in the allotment memo. The fee, should be remitted at the allotted college during admission. The fee as shown for courses in Self-Financing Dental Colleges is strictly provisional and candidates are liable to pay the fee at the revised rate as and when the fee for the academic year 2026-27 is fixed by Admission Supervisory Committee/Government/Hon'ble Court. The allotted candidates who do not

take admission in the respective colleges within the stipulated time and those candidates who quit the seats after taking admission will lose his/her present allotment as well as all the higher order options and will not be considered for phase 2 allotments. The registration fee of those candidates who do not join within the stipulated time after getting the allotment and those candidates who quit the seats after taking admission will be considered as penalty and will not be refunded. In the second phase counseling, there is no facility for fresh option registration for the candidates. Only option confirmation /deletion/re- arrangement of the existing options is possible. Option confirmation is compulsory to participate in Round 2. Option registration will be available only if any new course is added to the list at this stage.

All the college authorities should approve the list of admitted candidates through Online Admission Management System (OAMS) by **5:00 PM on 11.09.2026.**
