ALLOTMENT TO P G PHARMACY COURSES (M.PHARM), KERALA-2021
SCHEDULE FOR FIRST PHASE OF ALLOTMENT

The activities related to the first phase of centralized allotment to Post Graduate Pharmacy Course (M.Pharm) for the year 2021 commenced from **28.08.2022**.

Those candidates who are included in the rank list published by the Commissioner For Entrance Examinations for admission to M. Pharm course for the year 2021 can register their options on the Website **www.cee.kerala.gov.in** from **28.08.2022 to 31.08.2022, 10.00 AM**.

Candidate shall have to click '**M. Pharm 2021-Candidate Portal**' available in the above website. After that the candidates have to enter their **Application Number** and **Password** in order to access their home page. The Candidates can register their options online by clicking the menu item '**Option Registration**' available in the home page. Those candidates whose results have been withheld can also register options online. But the online options of such candidates will be considered for allotment only if they clear the withheld status by uploading the required certificate through the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in a day prior to the last date allotted for option registration.

The schedule for the allotment is given below

28.08.2022	Opening of the option registration facility.
31.08.2022, 10.00 AM	Closing of option registration facility.
02.09.2022	First Allotment- Provisional
03.09.2022	First Allotment
12.09.2022 to 16.09.2022, 3.00 PM	Payment of Fees and Joining in the Colleges
16.09.2022, 4.00 PM	All the college authorities should approve the list of admitted candidates through Online Admission Management System (OAMS).

The list of Pharmacy Colleges/Courses to which the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations makes allotment is provided in the Home page of the candidate portal. Candidates can give options as per their priority of the Course-College combinations in the option list. **A candidate needs only give options to a Course-College combination if he/she is sure to join the course and college, if allotted.** Options registered online alone will be considered for allotment to the courses. Options sent to the Office of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations via Post/Fax/E-mail will not be processed /considered for allotment to the courses.

Candidates allotted to courses, and who remit the fee as prescribed, should take admission in the college allotted as per the schedule prescribed by the CEE. Candidates who do not remit the prescribed fees/take admission will lose their allotment as well as the claims for further online allotments, if any. No extension of time for reporting to the college will be granted under any circumstances. The candidates are liable to pay admission fee as prescribed by the University concerned at the time of admission.

List of Colleges

The Commissioner for Entrance Examinations will be making allotment to the P G Pharmacy (M. Pharm) courses in all seats in Government colleges and Government seats in various self financing colleges in the first phase.

Fees

Colleges	Fees
Government Pharmacy Colleges	Tuition Fee: Rs. 27,570/- Per Annum
*Self Financing Colleges	Tuition Fee : Rs. 1,79,000 Per Annum

*Subject to the final approval from the Government.

The Candidates who are allotted in Government Pharmacy Colleges or in Government seats in Private Self financing Colleges shall have to pay the total fees at the college concerned at the time of admission. SC/ST/OEC/Children of Fisherman/ inmates of Sree Chithra Home, Nirbhaya Home and Juvenile Home candidates are exempted from payment of fees. The allotment to Colleges / Courses will be subject to recognition of All India Regulatory Bodies / Affiliation from the Universities concerned.
