**ALLOTMENT TO P G PHARMACY COURSES (M.PHARM),**  
**KERALA-2022**  
**ONLINE OPTIONS INVITED**

The activities related to the first phase of centralized allotment to Post Graduate Pharmacy Course (M.Pharm) for the year 2022 has commenced.

Those candidates who are included in the rank list published by the Commissioner For Entrance Examinations for admission to M. Pharm course for the year 2022 can register their options on the Website **www.cee.kerala.gov.in** up to **10.11.2023, 4.00 PM.**

Candidate shall have to click '**M. Pharm 2022-Candidate Portal**' available in the above website. After that the candidates have to enter their **Application Number** and **Password** in order to access their home page. The Candidates can register their options online by clicking the menu '**Option Registration**' available in the home page. Those candidates whose ranks have been withheld due to defects in their uploaded certificates can also register options online. But the online options of such candidates will be considered for allotment only if they clear their defects by uploading the required certificate through the website **www.cee.kerala.gov.in** a day prior to last date allotted for option registration.

The list of Pharmacy Colleges/Courses to which the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations makes allotment is provided in the Home page of the candidate. Candidates can give options as per their priority of the Course-College combinations in the option list. **A candidate need only give options to a Course-College combination if he/she is sure to join the course and college, if allotted.** Options registered online alone will be considered for allotment to the courses. Options sent to the Office of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations via Post/Fax/E-mail will not be processed /considered for allotment to the courses.

**Option Registration Fee:**

Those candidates who wish to register options will have to remit registration fee of Rs.5,000/- (Rupees Five Thousand Only) to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations. The registration fee will be adjusted in the tuition fee of those candidates who take admission consequent on allotments. Candidates belonging to SC/ST/OEC category and those having benefits as per G.O.(Ms) No.25/2005/SCSTDD Dated 20.06.2005 and G.O.(Ms)No.10/2014/BCDD Dated 23.05.2014 and those candidates from Juvenile Home, Nirbhaya Home, SreeChitra Home will have to remit Rs.500 /- (Rupees Five Hundred only) as Registration Fee. The Registration Fee of such candidates who take admission in the allotted college/course will be adjusted in the caution deposit. The registration

fee of those candidates who do not get allotment will be refunded. Bank account details shall have to be provided by the candidates for facilitating refund, if any.

Registration Fees can be remitted at any of the Head Post Offices in Kerala or by way of online payment. The list of Post Offices is available in the website.

Candidates allotted to courses, and who remit the fee as prescribed, should take admission in the college allotted as per the schedule prescribed by the CEE. Candidates who do not remit the prescribed fees/take admission will lose their allotment as well as the claims for further online allotments, if any. No extension of time for reporting to the college will be granted under any circumstances. The candidates are liable to pay admission fee as prescribed by the University concerned at the time of admission.

### **List of Colleges**

The Commissioner for Entrance Examinations will be making allotment to the P.G Pharmacy (M. Pharm) courses in all seats in Government colleges and Government seats in various self financing colleges in the first phase. The list of colleges participating in the allotment and the seat matrix have been made available in the website.

The Candidates who are allotted in Government Pharmacy Colleges or in Government seats in Private Self financing Colleges shall have to pay the total fees at the college concerned at the time of admission. SC/ST/OEC/Children of

Fisherman/ inmates of Sree Chithra Home, Nirbhaya Home and Juvenile Home candidates are exempted from payment of fees. The allotment to Colleges/Courses will be subject to recognition of All India Regulatory Bodies / Affiliation from the Universities concerned.
