NOTIFICATION

ADMISSION TO P G AYURVEDA COURSE- 2022 SPECIAL ROUND OF STRAY VACANCY FILLING

The Director of Ayurveda Medical Education vide letter No G33/209/2023/DAME dated 29.03.2023 has reported the vacancies that arose in various Government Ayurveda Medical Colleges due to vacant foreign quota seats that were left unfilled. The Commissioner for Entrance Examinations is to permit admission to eligible candidates to these seats as per the conditions and guidelines issued with regard to the Stray Vacancy Filling Allotment and conditions stipulated in the prospectus for Admission to P G Ayurveda 2022. The details of the vacancies reported are as follows.

These vacancies will be filled at the respective colleges based on the lists forwarded in accordance with the guidelines issued by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.

THREE LISTS HAVE BEEN ISSUED FOR SPECIAL ROUND OF STRAY VACANCY FILLING ALLOTMENT

Priority List I: Allotment List

An Allotment has been done based on the options registered by the eligible candidates, the vacancies available up to this phase , and the guidelines published by the CEE, excluding

- candidates allotted a seat in the Mop up phase/Stray Vacancy round irrespective of their joining status/allotted seats.
- candidates admitted to the course through phases up to the second round of Centralised Allotments.
- the ineligible candidates, published by the AACCC.

Joining Period :

Candidates eligible for admission and included in this list should report

before the concerned college authority and can take admission with all the documents, including the Allotment Memo, TC in original, and pay the requisite fee (after deducting the Mop-Up Registration Fee remitted by the candidate to the CEE) on or before **04.04.2023**, **2.00 PM**. If a candidate included in this list reports at the institution within the stipulated time limit, he/she must be considered for admission directly by the college authority as per the eligibility condition, and the details must be submitted through the College portal (OAMS) within the joining period mentioned above.

Priority List II: Probable candidates List:

If vacancies exist even after the Priority List 1: Allotment List has been considered, in accordance with the guidelines and instructions, Priority List II: Probable candidates List- including candidates who have registered valid options in the Mop up Counselling can be considered for allotment at the institutional level. List excludes

- candidates allotted a seat in the Mop up phase/Stray Vacancy round irrespective of their joining status/allotted seats.
- candidates admitted to the course through phases up to the second round of Centralised Allotments.
- ineligible candidates, published by the AACCC.

<u>**Reporting/Joining Period**</u>:

Candidates eligible for admission and included in this **Priority List II: Probable candidates List** shall report before the concerned college authority from **04.04.2023**, **2:00 PM to 08.04.2023**, **2.00 PM.** All documents including the TC in original, and the complete fee (if applicable) should be submitted/paid to the college before the end of the reporting period.

Priority List 3 : Eligible candidates List

If vacancies exist even after the first two lists have been considered, in accordance with the guidelines and instructions, candidates included in the Eligible candidates List and satisfying the eligibility conditions essential for admission to the course may be considered for admission to the remaining stray vacancies.

<u>Reporting/Joining Period</u>:

Candidates eligible for admission and included in this list shall report before the concerned college authority from **04.04.2023 to 08.04.2023**, **2.00 PM**, only if the vacancy exists in the college even after the Joining period for Priority List I: Allotment List has ended. All documents including the TC in original, and the complete fee (if applicable) should be submitted/paid to the college before the end of the reporting period.

In addition to the general conditions under which a candidate is not allowed to participate in the stray vacancy filling allotments, the condition that any candidate who takes admission through the Priority List I : Allotment list is also not allowed to change the allotment afterwards, is also applicable as far as eligibility for allotment under this phase is concerned.

Guidelines for Allotment (to be followed by the Colleges and candidates)

1. Stray vacancy filling should not be on a First-Come, First-Served basis.

2. Eligible candidates can report to the concerned college authority with all the required documents in original including the Transfer Certificate. All the documents listed in the prospectus, as the documents to be submitted to the college authority for taking admission, should be submitted to the concerned college authority before the end of the reporting period. 3. No actual seat allocation should be done before the end of the reporting period, and the admission finalization should be done in rank order only, from the candidates who reported before the college authority, satisfying the conditions in the previous Para. Admission finalization should be done only after the reporting period ends. Fees collected from candidates who are not finally admitted should be promptly refunded.

4. Admission to any category seat (if any) should be limited to candidates from the respective categories. However, in the event that not enough candidates report during the reporting period, the college authority can convert the category seat to another eligible category as per the prospectus condition. That is, for all the eligible candidates, the reporting period will end at **2.00 PM on 08.04.2023** irrespective of category conversion or not.

5. College authorities should verify the AIAPGET rank details, the State Merit List, and the category status of the candidates using the CEE Data Sheet to be brought by the candidates. Academic eligibility should also be verified by the college authority.

6. The colleges should forward the list of Admitted candidates to the CEE on **08.04.2023, 3:00 P.M**. The list should include the candidate's roll number, rank, admitted category, name, and reporting time. The details of all reporting candidates and rejected candidates (mentioning the reason) should also be forwarded to the CEE.

7. All the college authorities should update the details of stray vacancy admission through OAMS before **08.04.2023**, **5:00 P.M**

Candidates are requested to check the Priority Lists, Guidelines and Vacancy details published on the website. Candidates included in the Lists, may contact the college authorities concerned and participate in the allotment process before the stipulated time.
