ALLOTMENT TO PG AYURVEDA COURSES, KERALA-2022
ONLINE OPTIONS INVITED FOR THE FIRST PHASE OF ALLOTMENT

The activities related to the First Phase of Centralized Allotment to Post Graduate Ayurveda Degree/Diploma Courses for the year 2022-23 commenced on **20.01.2023**. All the eligible candidates who are included in the Kerala Merit List and Service Quota List published by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations and have applied for admission to P G Ayurveda Courses 2022 can register their options online through the website **www.cee.kerala.gov.in** from **20.01.2023** to **24.01.2023, 4.00 P M**.

Candidates shall have to click 'PG Ayurveda-2022-Candidate Portal' available on the above website and enter their application number and password in order to access their Home Page. Candidates can register their options online by clicking the menu item 'Option Registration' available on the Home Page.

The schedule for the allotment is given below:

20.01.2023	Opening of the option registration facility.
24.01.2023 - 4.00 PM	Closing of option registration facility.
27.01.2023	First Phase Provisional Allotment
28.01.2023	First Phase Final Allotment
30.01.2023 to 02.02.2023, 3.00 PM	Joining at the allotted colleges
02.02.2023, 4.00 PM	All the college authorities should approve the list of admitted candidates through the Online Admission Management System (OAMS).

Candidates can give options as per their priority of the Course-College combinations from the available options.

Candidate allotted to a course, should take admission in the college allotted as per the schedule prescribed by the CEE. Candidates who do not take admission will lose their allotment as well as their claims for further online allotments. No extension of time for reporting to the college will be granted under any circumstances. The candidates are liable to pay the admission fee as prescribed by the University concerned at the time of admission.

Fees:

Colleges	Fees
Government /Government Controlled Ayurveda Colleges	Tuition Fee: Rs. 16,540 per annum
Self-financing Ayurveda Colleges	Tuition Fee* : Rs 5,25000 for Clinical Subjects and 2,63000 for Non-Clinical Subjects.

*The fee structure will be as per the Govt.Order for the concerned year

Note:

1. Candidates of Kerala origin included in the Kerala Merit List can submit online options to be considered for allotment to Post Graduate Ayurveda Degree and Diploma Seats. However, both Keralite and Non Keralite candidates can register options to be considered for admission to the PG Ayurveda All India Quota seats available in the Self Financing Colleges.
2. Service Quota candidates shall register options for those seats that are reserved for their quota.
3. PwD Candidates must register options and be considered for admission to PG Ayurveda Degree/Diploma courses according to their suitability for pursuing courses/speciality.
4. SC /ST/OEC/ Children of Fishermen, inmates of Srichitra Home, Nirbhaya Home, Juvenile Home candidates are exempted from payment of fees.

Candidates allotted to various colleges, should take admission in the colleges and shall remit the fee shown in the Allotment Memo at the college

allotted as per the schedule prescribed by the CEE. No extension of time for joining the college will be granted under any circumstances.
