ALLOTMENT TO PG AYURVEDA DEGREE/DIPLOMA COURSES,
KERALA-2023
ONLINE OPTIONS INVITED FOR FIRST PHASE OF ALLOTMENT

The activities related to the First Phase of Centralized Allotment to Post Graduate Ayurveda Degree/Diploma Courses for the year 2023-24 commenced from **11.10.2023**. All the eligible candidates who have submitted their applications for admission to PG Ayurveda Courses-2023 can register their options online through the website **www.cee.kerala.gov.in** till **13.10.2023, 2.00 PM**.

Candidates shall have to click '**PG Ayurveda-2023-Candidate Portal**' available in the above website and enter their application number and password in order to access their Home Page. Candidates can register their options online by clicking the menu '**Option Registration**' available in Home Page.

A registration fee of Rs.10,000/- will have to be paid at the time of Option Registration. Candidates belonging to SC/ST/OEC category eligible for benefits as per G.O(Ms)No.25/2005/SCSTDD dated:20.06.2005 and G.O (Ms)No.10/20104/BCDD dated:23.05.2014 and those candidates from Juvenile Home, Nirbhaya Home, Sreechitra Home will have to remit Rs.5,000/- as registration fee. Those candidates who get an allotment and takes admission in the first phase, the registration fee will be adjusted to the tuition fee to be paid at the college or if the candidate does not get an allotment in this or subsequent phases, the registration fee will be refunded after the completion of the entire counseling

process. The registration fee of candidates eligible for fee concession who take admission in the allotted college will be refunded. The registration fee of those candidates who do not join, vacate or lapse the seats allotted to them after the date to be decided by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations will be considered as penalty.

The schedule for the allotment is given below:

11.10.2023	Opening of the option registration facility.
13.10.2023, 12.00 PM	Closing of option registration facility.
14.10.2023	First Phase Provisional Allotment
16.10.2023	First Phase Final Allotment
17.10.2023 to 19.10.2023, 3.00 PM	Joining at the allotted colleges
19.10.2023, 4.00 PM	All the college authorities should approve the list of admitted candidates through Online Admission Management System (OAMS).

Candidates can give options as per their priority of the Course-College combinations from the available options.

Candidate allotted to course, should take admission in the college allotted as per the schedule prescribed by the CEE. Candidate who fails to take admission will lose their allotment as well as the claims for further online allotments, if any. No extension of time for reporting to the college will be granted under any circumstances. The candidates are liable to pay admission fee as prescribed by the University concerned at the time of admission.

Note:

1. Candidates of Kerala origin can submit online options to be considered for allotment to Post Graduate Ayurveda Degree and Diploma Seats. However Keralite and Non Keralite candidates can register options to be considered admission to PG Ayurveda All India Quota seats available in the Self Financing Colleges.
2. Service Quota candidates shall register options to those seats which are reserved for their quota. Service candidates seeking admission in general quota shall register online options in general category also to be considered for allotment in the quota.
3. PwD Candidates shall register options and shall be considered for admission to PG Ayurveda Degree/Diploma courses according to the eligibility/suitability of the candidate for pursuing courses/specialty.
4. SC /ST/OEC/ Children Fishermen, inmates of Sri. Chitra Home, Nirbhaya Home, Juvenile Home candidates are exempted from payment of tuition fee.

Candidates allotted to various colleges, should take admission in the colleges and shall remit the fee shown in the Allotment Memo at the college allotted as per the schedule prescribed by the CEE. No extension of time for reporting/joining to the college will be granted under any circumstances.
