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# NOTIFICATION ADMISSION TO PG AYURVEDA (DEGREE & DIPLOMA) COURSES-2024

# FIFTH ROUND STRAY VACANCY ALLOTMENT CANDIDATES CAN SUBMIT ONLINE APPLICATION & REGISTER OPTIONS

The facility to submit fresh online applications for admission to P.G. Ayurveda Degree/ Diploma Courses for the academic year 2024-25 has been re-opened prior to fifth round stray vacancy allotment as per NCISM directives for the academic session 2024-25. Qualified candidates who have not yet registered their online applications can avail this facility up to 10.01.2025, 2:00 PM through the website **www.cee.kerala.gov.in** as per the conditions mentioned in the notification No. CEE/260/2024-TA3 dated 20.09.2024.

The Stray Vacancy allotment will be conducted to fill up the available vacant seats after fourth round stray vacancy allotment and further vacancies, if any, arising. Those fresh applicants, who find a place in the rank list, can participate in the upcoming stray vacancy filling allotments, subject to the condition that none of the allotments/admissions carried out in the previous phases are disturbed.

The candidates who have not already submitted applications to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations for admission to the Post Graduate Degree/Diploma Courses in Ayurveda can apply online till 10.01.2025, 2:00 PM through the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in.

## **Submission of Applications and Application Fee**

Qualified candidates who have not yet registered their online applications but

seeking admission to the Post Graduate Degree/Diploma Courses in Ayurveda can apply online till 10.01.2025, 2:00 PM through the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations by entering the required AIAPGET 2024 details and remitting the required application fee by way of online payment. Candidates shall upload the candidates' photo and signature, as well as all necessary certificates and documents, after paying the required application fee.

Application fee once remitted will not be refunded.

# **Last date of Application:**

Qualified candidates who have not yet registered their online applications but seeking admission to the courses should submit the online application along with uploaded Certificates/Documents mentioned in the prospectus before 10.01.2025, 2:00 PM. Defective and incomplete applications will be summarily rejected. No correspondence will be undertaken in this regard. After the submission of the application, candidates will NOT be allowed to include any information in the application form or to submit any certificates/documents claiming reservation or any benefits. The printout of the application or any document uploaded to the online application need not be sent to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.

This notification is published based on the short notice of NCISM dated. 08/01/2025. As per the direction, the whole admission process should be completed on 13.01.2025. Very limited time is available for application submission, verification of the application, option registration, and the processing of options for seat allotment. So the Candidates should take utmost care while filling the application form

and uploading the required documents so as to avoid errors and mistakes. Defective and incomplete applications will be summarily rejected. No correspondence will be undertaken in this regard. After the submission of the application, candidates will NOT be allowed to include any information in the application form or to submit any certificates/documents claiming reservation or any benefits.

On allotment of a seat, candidate should take admission in the college concerned as per the schedule prescribed by the CEE. Candidates who fail to take admission within the stipulated joining time, will lose the allotment as well as the claims for further allotments, if any. No extension of time for reporting at the college will be granted under any circumstances. Candidates are liable to pay admission fee as prescribed by the University concerned at the time of admission.

### Important conditions:

- 1. Candidates who have already submitted applications to the Commissioner for Entrance examinations should not submit new application. Multiple applications will lead to the cancellation of candidature.
- 2. Both Keralites and Non Keralites can apply but the eligibility for the various quotas will be as per the prospectus conditions and the government orders issued in this regard.
- 3. As per the directives (Ref.No.NCISM/ Examinations/State DME/2024 dt. 12.11.2024) of National Commission for Indian System of Medicine, the minimum percentile criteria of AIAPGET 2024 has been reduced by Fifteen (15) percentile across all categories for admission in PG courses of Ayurveda for the academic year 2024-25 and as per the directives (Ref.No.NCISM/ Examinations/State DME/2024 dt. 08.01.2025) the minimum percentile criteria of AIAPGET 2024 has been again reduced by Five (5) percentile for SC/ST category.

3. Fresh applicants who wish to be considered for admission to various reservation category seats or for any income based fee concessions should submit, along with the online application, the required supporting documents (Community Certificate, Non-creamy Creamy Layer Certificate for State education purpose, EWS certificate, income certificate, etc. as the case may be) to substantiate the claims for

reservation or fee concession. There will be no opportunity to submit supporting documents later under any circumstances. The reservation claims of fresh applicants will be confined to the vacant seats currently available or that may arise later on, under the respective reservation categories.

- 4. Candidates who have already applied for P G Ayurveda degree/ Diploma courses but have been served memo for rectifying defects in the documents for reservation claims can rectify the defects by uploading the required documents, availing this opportunity.
- 5. Candidates who have already completed their registration but payment was not made can complete the submission of application after paying the required application fees.
- 6. Service Quota seats are currently not available after the completion of the regular rounds of the centralised allotment process. Service Quota candidates can also submit fresh application but they will be considered only if service quota seats become vacant. Service quota candidates seeking admission in general quota shall register online options under the general quota also, in order to be considered for allotment in the general quota.
- 7. PwD quota seats are currently not available after the completion of the regular rounds of the centralised allotment process. PwD Quota candidates can submit fresh applications, but they will be considered only if PwD quota seats become vacant.
- 8. Candidates belonging to SC/ST/OEC categories, Children of Fishermen, inmates of Sree Chitra Home, Nirbhaya Home, Juvenile Home are exempted from payment of tuition fee.
- 9. All candidates are requested to go through the eligibility conditions, academic qualifications, documents required, etc. in the Notification dated, 20.09.2024 and Government approved Prospectus for admission to the Post Graduate Degree/Diploma Courses in Ayurveda courses available in the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in before submission of fresh application.

Candidates allotted to various colleges, should take admission in the respective colleges and shall remit the fee shown in the Allotment Memo at the college allotted as per the schedule prescribed by the CEE. No extension of time for reporting/joining at the college will be granted under any circumstances.

# ONLINE OPTIONS INVITED FOR FIFTH ROUND STRAY VACANCY ALLOTMENT

The new applicants should register online options after the successful submission of online application through the tab "**Option Registration**" available in the Application Page. They should register options on or before 10.01.2025, 3 PM. Candidate who have already submitted the application and figured in the rank list should register fresh options on or before 10.01.2025, 3 PM by clicking the menu **'Option Registration'** available in **'PG Ayurveda-2024-Candidate Portal'** available in the above website and enter their application number and password in order to access their Home Page.

#### **Conditions**

- 1. Those candidates who have not registered in Round I/ Round 2/ Round 3/SVR-1/SVR-II / SVR- III/ SVR IV shall have to pay registration fee for fresh registration.
- 2. Those who have already been admitted will not be eligible to participate for further allotments.
- 3. Those who have got allotment in third round allotment/ SVR-1/SVR-II/ SVR-III/ SVR -IV will not be eligible to participate for further allotments.
- 4. The options registered in the previous rounds will not be considered for stray vacancy round allotment. Hence, candidates shall have to register option afresh if they wish to participate in the stray vacancy round allotment.
- 5. If any candidate does not join seat allotted in stray vacancy round, he/she may exit with forfeiture of registration fee and cannot participate in further rounds of allotment.
- 6. If a candidate freshly register in stray vacancy round and is not allotted any seat, he/she is eligible to participate in further stray vacancy rounds, if any.
- 7. Candidates getting allotment in stray vacancy round shall not have any claim on earlier rounds' allotted seat.
- 8. Any candidate who is allotted a seat in this phase or any subsequent Stray Vacancy Filling Allotments, irrespective of whether he/she joins or not joins the allotted seat, will not be further considered in the subsequent allotments.
- 9. Those candidates who are included in the list of candidates prohibited from participation in further allotments, shared by the AACCC, which is available in the website, will not be considered for the stray vacancy

round allotment.

10. Those candidates who are blocked from further participation in state quota allotments on account of being admitted in AIQ seat will not be considered in this and subsequent phases of the state admission procedures and candidates allotted a seat in the third round and stray vacancy rounds of the All India Counseling will also be ineligible to participate in this and subsequent phases of the state allotments.

Option registration is a mandatory step of this phase irrespective of whether options were registered or not registered in the previous phases. The options have to be registered through the Online Option Registration facility accessible after logging on to the Candidate portal on the website, www.cee.kerala.gov.in by giving the Application Number & Password through the link "PG Ayurveda - 2024 Candidate Portal". Then by clicking the Menu 'Option Registration', candidates can register their options online within the stipulated time.

### **Registration Fees**

Those candidates who have not taken part in option registration in Round I/ Round 2/ Round 3/SVR 1/SVR II/ SVR III/SVR IV shall have to pay registration fee for fresh registration.

A registration fee of Rs.2,000/- will have to be paid at the time of Option Registration. Candidates belonging to SC/ST/OEC category eligible for benefits as per G.O(Ms)No.25/2005/SCSTDD dated:20.06.2005 and G.O (Ms)No.10/20104/BCDD dated:23.05.2014 and those candidates from Juvenile Home, Nirbhaya Home, Sreechitra Home will have to remit Rs.1,000/- as option registration fee. Registration fes can be remitted by way of online payment. The registration fee of those candidates who do not get allotment will be refunded. If a candidate gets allotment and does not join within the stipulated time, the option registration fee will be considered as penalty and will not be refunded. Option registration fee of the candidates who quit the seats after taking admission will be considered as penalty and will not be refunded. The registration fee of those candidates who do not join, vacate or lapse the seats allotted after the date to be notified by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations will be considered as penalty. Refund of option registration fee for the eligible candidates will be made only after the completion of allotment process and it will be notified.
