#### **ADMISSION TO POST GRADUATE DEGREE COURSE IN AYURVEDA,** **KERALA 2025** **REGISTRATION FACILITY OPENED**

Registration facility for online applications are opened to Post Graduate Degree Courses in Ayurveda in the Government, Aided and Self Financing Ayurveda Colleges of the State.

The result of the National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test for admission to PG (Ayurveda) Courses (AIAPGET 2025), conducted by NTA, New Delhi, has been published. The Commissioner for Entrance Examinations intends to initiate the registration process for candidates who have qualified in AYUSH PGET 2025 and wish to participate in the allotment of PG Ayurveda courses in the state for the year 2025.

The facility for online registration is available on the website of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations: **[www.cee.kerala.gov.in](http://www.cee.kerala.gov.in)**. Qualified candidates may register their names, mobile number and email id through the above website. This is a preliminary step to identify candidates interested in applying for PG Ayurveda 2025. A detailed notification regarding submission of application will be issued once the Prospectus for admission to PG Ayurveda courses is published. At that time, registered candidates will be able to complete and submit their applications online.

**IMPORTANT: This registration process is only a preliminary step to identify candidates interested in applying for PG Ayurveda courses and to avoid last-minute rush. Registered candidates will be required to complete the application process once the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations activates the website for this purpose, following the publication of the Prospectus.**

**Qualifying Criteria:** All candidates seeking PG (Ay) courses in the State of Kerala for the academic year 2025-26 must have qualified for the National Eligibility – Cum Entrance Test for PG (Ay) Courses (AYUSH PGET 2025) conducted by NTA, New Delhi and should figure in the rank list prepared by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations. The minimum eligibility mark in the entrance test (AIAPGET 2025) shall be the 50 th percentile in the case of General/ EWS category and that of SC/ST/SEBC category shall be the 40th percentile. In respect of Differently Abled Candidates category, the minimum mark shall be at the 45 th percentile for the General/ EWS Category and the 40 th percentile for the SC/ST/SEBC category

**\*Academic Qualifications:** Passing marks for eligibility in admission to ASU&H- PG courses should be as per ASU&H-PG regulations. Candidates must possess BAMS degree or provisional degree certificate recognized as per the provisions of the IMCC 1970/ NCISM 2020 Act and possess permanent or provisional registration certificate issued by the CCIM/NCISM/State/UTs Board , and must have completed a satisfactorily one- year compulsory rotating internship as per the NCISM notification( for the academic year 2025-26 only)
