ADMISSION TO PG AYURVEDA COURSES - 2025
FACILITY FOR CORRECTING DEFECTS IN THE ONLINE APPLICATION

Candidates who have applied online for admission to the PG Ayurveda Course for the academic year 2025 can view their profile details by entering their Application Number and Password on the page available by clicking on the link **‘PG Ayurveda 2025-Candidate Portal’** in the website, **www.cee.kerala.gov.in**. Candidates can verify details such as Nationality, Nativity, Date of Birth, Communal Reservation, Fee Reservation, Income etc. Those who have defects in their online application shall click the menu **‘Memo Details’** available on the Home page and upload the required documents /certificates to correct the defects **on or before 4.00 PM on 23.09.2025**. The required documents should be uploaded online and not to be sent to the Office of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.

Defects in Nativity given as memo in the candidate portal should also be rectified by uploading valid documents as directed. As per the provisions laid down in the prospectus candidates belonging to the Keralite category alone are eligible for any type of reservation or fee concession. If defects in nativity are not rectified within the stipulated time, reservation claims for such candidates will be cancelled even though they have submitted certificates to prove their reservation claim. No other chance will be provided to rectify the defects in the online application.
