**NOTIFICATION**

**ALLOTMENT / ADMISSION TO POST GRADUATE MEDICAL DEGREE COURSES, KERALA -2021**  
**CANDIDATES CAN SUBMIT ONLINE APPLICATION AND**  
**REGISTER OPTIONS FOR THE CENTRALISED ALLOTMENT PROCESS**

Applications are invited from candidates who have qualified in the NEET-PG 2021, for admission to **Post Graduate Medical Degree Courses, 2021** in the State Quota Seats by the Government Medical Colleges and Regional Cancer Centre (RCC), Thiruvananthapuram and to the entire seats including minority Quota and NRI Quota seats available in Private Self Financing Medical Colleges in Kerala. Qualified candidates can submit Online Application from **15.01.2022 to 22.01.2022, 5.00 pm** through the website of Commissioner for Entrance Examinations [www.cee.kerala.gov.in](http://www.cee.kerala.gov.in).

**Note:** *Allotment of seats from the rank list for all courses in Self Financing colleges will be made in accordance with orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India/Hon'ble High Court of Kerala or the orders of the Government of Kerala/Government of India as per the law in existence at the time of the Centralized Allotment Process (CAP).*

1. **Eligibility for Admission:**

a. **Academic:** Applicants should be in possession of MBBS degree or provisional MBBS pass certificate recognized by MCI with MBBS qualification registered permanently or provisionally with MCI or State Medical Council and should have completed one year of internship on or before 30<sup>th</sup> September 2021. Admission to such candidates will be given only after obtaining registration of T.C. Medical Council.

(b) **Nativity:** Applicants should have satisfied any of the following conditions.

- i) Indian Citizens of Kerala origin.
- ii) Persons of Indian Origin (PIO)/Overseas Citizens of India (OCI) will be considered only for the NRI quota seats available in self-financing Medical Colleges, as per Gazette of India notification dated. 4.3.2021. POI/OCI candidates will not be eligible for any kind of reservation.
- iii) Candidates who are sons/daughters of Non-Keralite parents, who have obtained MBBS Degree from any of the Medical Colleges in the State of Kerala. But they will not be eligible for Communal/Special/PD reservation benefits.

(c) **Age:** (i) There is no Upper age limit for admission to PG Medical courses under General quota.

(ii) For Medical Education Service Quota candidates, upper age limit will be 47 years and for Health Service Quota and Insurance Service Quota candidates, the upper age limit will be 45 years as on 23.02.2021 (prospectus clause 4.3).

(d) **Qualifying criteria:-** All candidates seeking admission to Post Graduate Medical Degree courses in the State of Kerala for the academic year 2021-22 shall have to qualify the National Eligibility Cum Entrance Test for Post-Graduate Courses (NEET PG-2021) conducted by the National Board of Examination, New Delhi. In order to be eligible for admission in any Post Graduate Medical course in 2021-22, it shall be necessary for a candidate to obtain a minimum of marks at 50<sup>th</sup> percentile in the NEET PG 2021. However in respect of candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes (SC), Scheduled Tribes (ST), Socially and Educationally Backward Classes (SEBC), SC-PwD, ST-PwD, SEBC- PwD the minimum marks shall be at 40<sup>th</sup> percentile. In respect of General- PwD candidates, the minimum marks shall be at 45<sup>th</sup> percentile.

3. **Mode of selection:-**

The selection of the candidates shall be made from the rank list prepared by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, Kerala on the basis of NEET PG 2021 rank list subject to satisfying the eligibility conditions as in Clause 4 of the prospectus.

4. **Submission of Applications and Application Fee:** All candidates seeking admission to the PG Medical Degree Courses 2021 can apply Online from 15.01.2022 through the website [www.cee.kerala.gov.in](http://www.cee.kerala.gov.in) of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations and then remit the required fee by way of online payment or by way of e-challan available during the submission of online application. Payment through e-challan can be made in cash at any of the Head/Sub Post offices in Kerala. After remitting the required application fee the candidate should upload signature and all necessary certificates as proof for various claims. Facility for registering options for the first phase of the centralized allotment process to be conducted by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations will be provided as part of the online application procedure and will open on 19.01.2022. **No need to send print out of the Application Acknowledgement page or any documents to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.**

The In-service candidates should send the print out of the Application Acknowledgement page along with print out of the uploaded documents to the Head of the department concerned before 5 pm on **22.01.2022.**

**Application Fee:**

Application Fee for General Candidates and for the In-service candidates is **Rs.1000/-** (Rupees Thousand only) and in the case of SC/ST candidates and those

eligible for SC/ST benefits as per G.O.(Ms)No.25/05/SCSTDD dated 20.06.2005 is **Rs.500/-** (Rupees Five hundred only). Application fee once remitted will not be refunded. The Prospectus can be downloaded from the website of Commissioner for Entrance Examinations. The application forms and prospectus will not be available from the Medical Colleges or from the Office of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.

5. **Last date and Time for the submission of online application:** All candidates seeking admission to the course should submit the online application along with uploaded documents/certificates mentioned in clause 8 of the prospectus **before 5 pm on 22.01.2022**. Late, defective and incomplete applications will be summarily rejected. No correspondence will be undertaken in this regard.
6. The candidates claiming reservation under scheduled castes/Scheduled Tribes/SEBC/EWS/Special quota seats should upload necessary certificates and documents in proof of their claim from the concerned authorities in the prescribed format together with the Online Application.
7. The admissions to the State Quota seats in Govt. Medical colleges and Regional Cancer Centre (RCC), Thiruvananthapuram and to the entire PG Medical Degree Seats including Minority Quota and NRI Quota in Self-financing Medical Colleges in the state for the year 2021-22 shall be done through a common counseling to be conducted by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations from State Rank lists which will be prepared on the basis of NEET-PG 2021 rank list.
8. **Admission under NRI Quota:**

“An applicant, who depends upon his/her Father/Mother/Brothers and Sisters (inclusive of first cousins)/Husband/Wife/Brothers and Sisters (inclusive of first cousins) of Father or Mother/Half Brother/Half Sister/Adopted Father or Adopted Mother working abroad” is eligible to apply under NRI Quota.

The Candidates seeking admission to the NRI quota seats in Self- financing Medical Colleges in the state shall have to upload the following Certificates/documents during the submission of Online Applications as per **G.O. (Rt)NO 375/2020/H&FWD dated 22.02.2020**.

- a. Passport copy and Visa attested by the Embassy/Green Card/Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) documents of their respective sponsors. The job of the sponsor should be mentioned in any of the above documents.
- b. The validity of the Visa should be up to the closing date of admission to PG Medical courses for the year 2021-22.
- c. Employment certificate of the sponsor attested by the Embassy/Consulate authorities (In case, the employment of the sponsor is not mentioned in the documents such as Passport copy and Visa attested by the Embassy/Green Card/Overseas Citizen of India (OCI)).
- d. Relationship certificate showing the relationship between sponsor and the student to be issued by the revenue authorities (Exact relationship should be established) as per the G.O (Ms) No. 243/14/H&FWD dated 06.08.2014. If the sponsor is the Father/Mother of the applicant, educational certificates of the applicant containing the name of the sponsor shall also be accepted.

- e. The sworn affidavit from the Sponsor in the stamp paper worth Rs. 200/- should be produced. The same shall also be notarized by the Notary Public, disclosing that the student is dependent of the sponsor and all the expenses i.e. tuition fee and special fee, of the candidate for the entire course period will be borne by the Sponsor.
- f. In case the Sponsor is abroad, the sponsor has to submit the sworn affidavit notarized by the Notary Public/Consulate/Embassy as per the rules and regulations prevailing in the respective country where the sponsor is presently working disclosing that the student is dependent of the sponsor and all the expenses, ie. tuition fee and special fee of the candidate for the entire course period will be borne by the sponsor.

**9. Admission under Minority Quota:** Candidates who want to take admission under Minority quota (Christian/Muslim) seats of Post Graduate Medical courses in the Self-financing colleges having Minority status, should upload the Non-creamy layer certificate for Kerala State Education purpose/ Minority/Community Certificate from the Village Officer concerned.

**10. Admission under EWS Quota:** The candidates eligible for EWS Quota seats should submit the EWS Certificate/documents from the Village Officer in the prescribed format as per G.O.(MS)No.2/2020/P&ARD from the Personnel and Administrative Reforms (Rules) Department) dated. 12.02.2020 (If applicable).

11. Candidates will be allowed, neither to include any information in the application form nor to submit any certificates/documents claiming reservation or any benefits, after the submission of the application.

**12. Data Sheet:** Candidates eligible for allotment/admission to the courses will be issued Data Sheet which can be downloaded from the website [www.cee.kerala.gov.in](http://www.cee.kerala.gov.in) from the date which will be notified later.

### **OPTION REGISTRATION FOR THE CENTRALIZED ALLOTMENT PROCESS**

In order to participate in the first phase of the centralized process (CAP) to be conducted by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, candidates should register options online as part of the online application process.

The option registration facility will be opened from **19.01.2022 up to 22.01.2022, 5.00 pm**. Candidates can submit options by clicking the menu item 'Option Registration' available in the home page. The list of Medical colleges/courses to which Commissioner for Entrance Examinations makes allotments will be available in the option registration page. Candidate can give options as per their priority of the course-college-quota combinations in the option list. A candidate need to only give options to a course-college-quota combination, if he/she is sure to join the course and college under the chosen quota, if allotted. Based on the options filed by the candidates within the stipulated time the first phase allotment will be published on **27.01.2022**. Detailed notification in this regard will be published later.

**NOTE:** SC/ST/OEC/Children of Fishermen/Inmates of Sri Chithra Home, Nirbhaya Home, Juvenile home candidates are exempted from payment of fees.

- The nativity/community/category claims (including Minority/NRI/service quota) made by the candidates in the online application will be rejected, if the required documents are not uploaded to the online application within the stipulated time.*
- As the allotment to any category or quota seat which a candidate is not eligible for will result in the loss of not only the allotted seat but also all the lower options and any other options which require that category or quota eligibility as a prerequisite, candidates must exercise utmost care while choosing the eligible category claim in the online application. So candidates are advised not to make any category or quota claim in their online application which they would not be able to substantiate with the prescribed supporting documents within the stipulated time limit.*
- Never register options to any course or college or quota which the candidate would not like to join if allotted.*

The selection and allotment of seats including those of In-service candidates will be made by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations through the Centralized Allotment Process (CAP) as per Clause 10 of the Prospectus for admission to Medical Post Graduate Degree courses-2021, approved by the Government of Kerala.

Candidates may go through the various provisions of the Prospectus for admission to Medical Post Graduate Degree courses-2021, available on the Official website of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations [www.cee.kerala.gov.in](http://www.cee.kerala.gov.in) before filling up the Online application forms.
