**ADMISSION TO PG MEDICAL COURSES-2021**  
**FIRST PHASE CENTRALISED ALLOTMENT PUBLISHED**

The first phase of Centralised allotment to PG Medical (Degree) Courses for the academic year 2021-22 in Government Medical Colleges in the State, Regional Cancer Centre (RCC), Thiruvananthapuram and Private Self Financing Medical colleges is published in the website [www.cee.kerala.gov.in](http://www.cee.kerala.gov.in). The allotment is based on the rank in the Kerala State merit list published by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations and online options filed by the candidates from 19.01.2022 to 30.01.2022, 5.00 pm. The online options registered by candidates whose results have been withheld and of those candidates who have been disqualified based on the Kerala State Rank list have not been considered in the allotment. The allotment to service quota seats is not included in this phase of allotment as the finalised service quota ranklist has not been furnished. The allotment result is available in the website of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations [www.cee.kerala.gov.in](http://www.cee.kerala.gov.in).

To view the allotment result, candidates should log on to the 'PG Medical 2021-candidate portal' by submitting their Application Number and Password. Then by clicking on the link 'Allotment Result', candidates can view their allotment result. It is necessary to take a printout of the Allotment memo. Those candidates who receive an allotment shall have to remit the full fees to the allotted college itself and should take admission within the stipulated time.

The allotted candidates should report for joining at the allotted colleges from **02.2.2022 to 05.2.2022, 4.00 pm** along with the required documents specified in the allotment memo (See clause 8 of the prospectus). The allotted candidates who do not take admission in the respective college before the time specified will lose their present allotment as well as all the higher order options. Such candidates will not be considered for further online centralised allotment.

All college authorities should approve the list of admitted candidates through Online Admission Management System (OAMS) at **5.00 pm on 05.2.2022**.

**Note:** Candidates who have claimed SC/ST reservation and whose caste status is under scrutiny by KIRTADS have been provisionally considered for allotment. The allotment/admission, if any, of such candidates shall be purely provisional and subject to final verification of their caste status.
