Second Phase Allotment to Post Graduate Medical (Degree) Courses, Kerala – 2021

The second phase of Centralized allotment to Post Graduate Medical Degree Courses for the academic year 2021 in the State commences from **09/02/2022**. The newly included courses/seats of 4 self financing Medical Colleges shall also to be filled up in this phase of allotment.

Option Confirmation is mandatory

Online Option Confirmation is mandatory for participating in the second phase of the allotment process. Candidates included in the state rank list published by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations can log in to the website **www.cee.kerala.gov.in** and then click the link '**PG Medical 2021-Candidate Portal**' to access their home page.

Following candidates are eligible to participate in the Second phase of allotment by clicking the '**Confirm**' button available in the home page of the Candidate Portal.

- Candidates who have received an allotment in the first phase and got admitted to the allotted colleges.
- Candidates who have not received any allotment in the first phase, and who want to be considered for the second phase of allotment.
- Candidates who wish to register fresh options for the newly included course/colleges in the second phase of allotment.

Candidates can re-arrange/delete their existing higher order options and also register fresh options to the newly included courses after clicking the '**Confirm**' button

available therein. Those who do not Confirm their options online will not be considered for the second phase of allotment for the existing options.

The schedule for the second phase of allotment is given below

09.02.2022	Website opens for enabling Online Option Confirmation, rearrangement/deletion of existing higher options and for registration of fresh options to the newly included courses/colleges.
13.02.2022, 10.00 AM	Facility for Online Option Confirmation and rearrangement/deletion/registration of options ends.
15.02.2022	Publication of second phase allotment
17.2.2022 to 21.2.2022, 2.00 PM	All candidates who get an allotment should join the course and college to which they are allotted along with the required documents and pay the fee at the colleges*.
21.2.2022, 3.00 PM	College authorities shall have to approve and submit the list of admitted candidates to the CEE through the Online Admission Management System (OAMS)

Candidates allotted to courses, shall remit the prescribed fee at the college and take admission in the college/course allotted as per the schedule prescribed by the CEE. No extension of time for reporting to the college will be granted under any circumstances. Candidates are liable to pay admission fee as prescribed by the University concerned at the time of admission.

* The fee in respect of Self Financing Medical Colleges is revised as per G.O.(MS) No. 26/2022/H&FWD dated . 25.01.2022.

Note: Second phase allotment is the final centralized allotment. The conditions of exit including liquidated damages as per Clause 12.2.1 of PG Medical prospectus 2021 will be applicable.
