**ADMISSION TO P G MEDICAL COURSES, KERALA-2021**  
**SECOND ALLOTMENT PUBLISHED**

The Second Phase Allotment to the P G Medical Courses-2021 in the Government Medical Colleges in the State, Regional Cancer Centre (RCC), Thiruvananthapuram and Private Self Financing Medical Colleges is published herewith.

This allotment is based on the rank in the Kerala State Merit List & Category List and on the basis of options filed by the candidates. The allotment result is available in the Candidate Portal in the website of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, [www.cee.kerala.gov.in](http://www.cee.kerala.gov.in).

To view the allotment result, candidates should log on to the '**PG Medical 2021 – Candidate Portal**' by submitting their **Application Number** and **Password**. Then by clicking on the link '**Allotment Result**', candidates can view their allotment result.

The allotted candidates should report physically for joining at the allotted colleges from **5.3.2022 to 8.3.2022, 2.00 PM** along with the required documents specified in the Allotment Memo. It is necessary to take a printout of the Second Phase Allotment Memo. The fee should be remitted at the allotted college during admission. All the college authorities should approve the list of admitted candidates through Online Admission Management System (OAMS) before **3.00PM on 8.3.2022**.

**Note: Those candidates who do not join the colleges allotted within the stipulated time will lose their allotment.**

**Conditions of Exit and Guidelines for Mop-up Counselling**

1. Those candidates who have joined P G Course in State Quota in the Second Allotment shall not be eligible to participate in the Mop-up Counselling.

2. Candidates who have been allotted PG Course in the State Quota on exit after being allotted to the seats in the second round will have to forfeit 10% of the annual fee if they do not join the course. ie, exit shall be allowed only after the forfeiture of 10% of the total annual fee during the second phase and if they have joined the course they will not be eligible for further counselling.

3. However, Candidates already holding a PG seat will be allowed to participate in the Mop-up Counselling only after surrender of the seat held by them on or before the last date for surrender of seats which will be notified by CEE before the date of Mop-up Counselling, and after forfeiture of 10% of the total annual fee.

4. In case an applicant retains seat in the First Allotment and is not allotted any seat in the Second Allotment, then this seat allotted in the First Allotment shall be considered as equivalent to the seat allotted in the Second Allotment and candidate will have to forfeit 10% of the total annual fee if he/she decides to quit before the last date of surrender of seats.

5. Course once allotted in the Mop-up Counselling shall be final. Mere surrender/exchange of seat in the Mop-up Counselling will not be allowed. Surrender of seats after allotment in the Mop-up Counselling will also not be permitted.
