**ADMISSION TO PG MEDICAL COURSES-2021**  
**ONLINE MOP UP ALLOTMENT LIST PUBLISHED**

The Online Mop up Allotment to the P G Medical (Degree ) courses 2021 to fill up vacant seats in the Government Medical Colleges in the State, Regional Cancer Centre (RCC), Thiruvananthapuram and Private Self Financing Medical colleges is published in the website [www.cee.kerala.gov.in](http://www.cee.kerala.gov.in).

As per the Kerala Government Prospectus for admission to PG Medical courses for the academic year 2021-22 vide approved by GO(Ms)No18/2022/H&FWD dated 15.01.2022, clause 10.1.18.-Mop up Round it is stated as follows: ***“A candidate who figures in the rank list /category lists prepared as a per clause 9 of the prospectus for the admission to the PG Medical degree course 2021-22 but not joined in the All India quota/state quota seats alone, is entitled to attend the Mop up round process.”***

On 29.04.2022, Medical Counseling Committee under Director General of Health Services, Ministry of Health, Govt. Of India has released the ‘Admitted candidates list PG up to Mop up Round’.

In compliance with the **Prospectus clause 10.1.18, admitted candidates as per the above list has been excluded from the Allotment List published herewith and those candidate who had registered options for State Mop up and have not joined in All India /State seats have been included in the Allotment List.** With this the Provisional List published earlier stands cancelled and no claim to any seat based on the Provisional List will be considered.

To view the Allotment Result, candidates should log on to the ‘PG Medical 2021-Candidate Portal’ by submitting their Application Number and Password. Then by clicking on the link ‘Allotment Result’, candidates can view their Allotment Result. Those candidates who get an allotment as per the Allotment List published will have to report at the colleges allotted **before 1.00 PM of 01.05.2022**.They should submit the Allotment Memo, Data Sheet and originals of all documents and pay the prescribed fee

at the College. The College authorities should update the Online Admission Management System (OAMS) before **2.00 PM of 01.05.2022**.

Course once allotted in the online Mop-up Round shall be final. Surrender of seats after allotment in the online Mop up Round will not be permitted. Those candidates who do not join the seat allotted through Mop up Round or vacate the seat admitted after Mop up Allotment will be liable to pay liquidated damages as stipulated in clause 12.2.1 of the Prospectus for admission to PG Medical courses 2021. Those candidates who vacate their seats admitted through previous allotments conducted by Commissioner for Entrance Examinations after 26.04.2022 will also be liable to pay liquidated damages.

In case vacancies exist/new vacancies arise after Mop up Allotment, these will also be filled in the subsequent phase, Stray Vacancy Filling Round. The Guidelines for Stray Vacancy Filling round will be notified later.
