ALLOTMENT TO PG MEDICAL COURSES- 2023 SECOND PHASE
ALLOTMENT FACILITY FOR OPTION CONFIRMATION/
REGISTRATION/ DELETION/REARRANGEMENT AVAILABLE

The second phase of Centralized allotment to Post Graduate Medical Degree Courses for the academic year 2023 in the State commences from **01.09.2023**. The newly included courses/seats shall also to be filled up in this phase of allotment.

Candidates included in the State merit list published by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations can log in to the website **www.cee.kerala.gov.in** and then click the link '**PG Medical 2023-Candidate Portal**' to access their home page. Candidates can then re-arrange/delete their existing higher order options if needed after clicking the '**Confirm**' button available therein. Candidates who have not received any allotment in the first phase can also rearrange/delete their existing options. The facility for online option confirmation/deletion/re-arrangement shall be available in the above website from **01.09.2023 to 04.09.2023 10.00 AM**.

Option Confirmation is mandatory

In the Second Phase counseling there is no facility for fresh option registration for the candidates. Only option confirmation/deletion/re-arrangement of the existing options in Phase 2 is possible. Option confirmation is compulsory to participate in Phase 2. Option registration will be available only if any new course is added to the list at this stage. If a candidate is allotted a seat in the first round and joined the allotted seat, his/her higher options will be retained and all

those options listed below the allotted option will automatically be deleted thus enabling only upgradation/retention in the same seat. If a candidate joined in a seat in Phase 1 does not give confirmation of option in the Phase 2 he will not be considered for upgradation in Phase 2, but the seat joined in Phase 1 will be retained. So if a candidate joined in Phase 1 does not want upgradation in Phase 2 he/she may not confirm options or after confirmation delete all options registered.

Service Quota Candidates :- The rank list of Service Quota Candidates has been published in the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in. Candidates included in the Service Quota Rank List can register their options for admission to PG Medical Course 2023 in this phase.

Following candidates are eligible to participate in the Second phase of allotment by clicking the '**Confirm**' button available in the home page of the Candidate Portal.

- Candidates who have received an allotment in the first phase and got admitted to the allotted colleges and continue in their admitted status.
- Candidates who have not received any allotment in the first phase, and who want to be considered for the second phase of allotment.
- Candidates who wish to register fresh options for the newly included Colleges/courses in the second phase of allotment.

Candidates who will be excluded from Phase 2 State Counseling:

- A candidate who was allotted a seat in Phase 1 of State counseling but did not join the allotted seat.*
- A candidate who joined the allotted seat in Phase 1 of State counseling but after that vacated the seat.*

** But they can register options for the new Colleges- courses added in this phase*

The schedule for the second phase of allotment is given below:

01.09.2023	Website opens for enabling Online Option Confirmation, rearrangement/deletion of existing higher options and for registration of fresh options to the newly included colleges-courses.
04.09.2023, 10.00AM	Facility for Online Option Confirmation and rearrangement/deletion/registration of options ends.
05.09.2023	Publication of second phase provisional allotment.
06.09.2023	Publication of second phase final allotment.
08.09.2023 to 11.09.2023, 3.00PM	All candidates who get an allotment should join the course and college to which they are allotted along with the required documents and pay the fee at the colleges.
11.09.2023, 4.00 PM	College authorities shall have to approve and submit the list of admitted candidates to the CEE through the Online Admission Management System (OAMS)

Candidates allotted to courses, shall remit the prescribed fee at the college and take admission in the college-course allotted as per the schedule prescribed by the CEE. No extension of time for reporting to the college will be granted under any circumstances. Candidates are liable to pay admission fee as prescribed by the University concerned at the time of admission. The fee of Self-financing medical colleges is as per the fee fixed by ASC for the academic year 2022-23 and is subject to change and the candidate is liable to pay fee at the revised rate as and when fixed by ASC/Govt. for the academic year 2023-24.

Note: Candidates who belong to SC/ST/OEC/Children of Fisherman/Inmates of Sree Chithra Home, Nirbhaya Home, Juvenile Home are exempted from payment of fees.

The allotment to Colleges/Courses will be subject to recognition of All India Regulatory Bodies/Affiliation from the University concerned.
