**ALLOTMENT/ADMISSION TO PG MEDICAL COURSES-2023**  
**Re-opening of application submission facility following lowering of**  
**the minimum qualifying percentile**

The NEET-PG-2023 minimum qualifying percentiles have been lowered to ZERO across all categories by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare as per Notice No. U.12021/07/2023-MEC(pt-1) dated 20.09.2023.

In accordance with the same online application submission facility based on revised minimum qualifying criteria for PG Medical-2023 courses in Government, Self-financing Medical Colleges, and Regional Cancer Centre in Kerala will be opened from **22.09.2023 to 28.09.2023, 03.00 PM**. In this phase of online application submission, only those candidates who have freshly qualified as per the revised qualification criteria will be able to submit the applications.

**The candidates should also satisfy all eligibility conditions as specified in Clause 4 of the prospectus. In-service candidates who are newly qualified as per the revised NEET-PG qualifying criteria shall also apply if they satisfy the eligibility conditions specified in Prospectus clause 6.6.12.**

**The candidates who have applied for the PG medical allotment course 2023 vide notification dated 07.07.2023, but were excluded from the merit list due to the failure to upload the relevant documents in the stipulated time to substantiate their claim, will not be allowed the category reservation, even though they submit relevant documents in this stage. Such candidates can participate in the allotment process as General Category only.**

Candidates submitting fresh applications with any community reservation claim and with a percentile higher than the 39<sup>th</sup> percentile and lower than the 50<sup>th</sup> percentile and candidates submitting fresh applications in the PwD category with

a percentile higher than the 44<sup>th</sup> percentile and lower than the 50<sup>th</sup> percentile will be considered as General Candidates even if they submit the required certificates and documents in proof of their claim.

Candidates can avail the application submission facility through the link '**PG Medical 2023 – Re-Opening Online Application**' on the website **www.cee.kerala.gov.in**. and should complete the online submission of the application and upload the required documents within the deadline. Those candidates who wish to apply for Community and Minority quota, NRI seats in self-financing Medical Colleges should also upload the certificates from the authorities concerned and all other valid and relevant documents in support of the claim. Newly qualified candidates, who find a place in the rank list, can participate in the third phase allotment subject to the condition that none of the allotments/admissions carried out in the previous allotments is disturbed.

Allotment of seats from the rank list for all courses in Self Financing Medical colleges will be made in accordance with orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India /Hon'ble High Court of Kerala or the orders of the Government of Kerala/Government of India or as per the law in existence at the time of the Centralized Allotment Process (CAP)
