ALLOTMENT TO PG MEDICAL COURSES- 2024
SECOND PHASE ALLOTMENT
FACILITY FOR OPTION CONFIRMATION/
REGISTRATION/ DELETION/REARRANGEMENT
AVAILABLE

The second phase Centralized allotment to Post Graduate Medical Degree Courses for the academic year 2024 in the State commences from **12.12.2024**. The newly included courses/seats shall also be filled up in this phase.

Candidates including Service Quota candidates included in the State merit lists published by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations can log in to the website **www.cee.kerala.gov.in** and then click the link '**PG Medical 2024-Candidate Portal**' to access their home page. Candidates can then re-arrange/delete their existing higher order options if needed after clicking the '**Confirm**' button available therein. Candidates who have not received any allotment in the first phase can also rearrange/delete their existing options. The facility for online option confirmation/deletion/re-arrangement shall be available in the above website from **12.12.2024 to 17.12.2024, 11:00 AM**.

Option Confirmation is mandatory

In the Second Phase counseling, there is no facility for fresh option registration in respect of the options that were available in the first phase itself. Option confirmation/deletion/re-arrangement of the existing options

is possible in this phase. Option confirmation is compulsory to participate in in this phase. Option registration will be available only if any new course is added to the centralised allotment process at this stage. If a candidate was allotted a seat in the first phase and joined the allotted seat, his/her higher higher options (those above the allotted option) are available for confirmation/deletion/re-arrangement in this phase and all the lower options (those below the allotted option) have automatically been deleted thus allowing only up-gradation to a higher option or retention of the same seat. If a candidate who joined the course allotted in the first phase does not confirm that the higher options are to be considered for allotment in the second phase, he/she will not be considered for up-gradation in the second phase, but the seat allotted in the first phase will be retained. So, if a candidate who joined the course allotted in the first phase does not want up-gradation in the second phase, he/she need not confirm the higher options or can delete the higher options.

The candidates who were allotted a seat in the first phase but did not take admission in the respective colleges within the stipulated time and those candidates who quit the seats after taking admission will lose their present allotment as well as all the higher order options and will not be considered for the second phase allotment except that options can be registered for the newly added courses/colleges. The registration fee of such candidates who did not join within the stipulated time after getting the allotment and those candidates who quit the seats after taking admission is considered as penalty and will not be refunded. However, such candidates can register options for newly included courses after payment of option registration fee.

Following candidates are eligible to participate in the Second phase allotment by clicking the ‘**Confirm**’ button available in the home page of the Candidate Portal.

- Candidates who have received an allotment in the first phase and got admitted to the allotted colleges and continue in their admitted status.
- Candidates who have not received any allotment in the first phase, and who want to be considered for the second phase of allotment.
- Candidates who wish to register fresh options for the newly included Colleges/courses in the second phase of allotment.

Candidates who will be excluded from Phase 2 :

- A candidate who was allotted a seat in the first phase of the State counseling but did not join the allotted seat.*
- A candidate who joined the allotted seat in the first phase of the State counseling but after that vacated the seat.*

** But they can register options for the new Colleges- courses added in this phase*

Tentative schedule for the second phase allotment

12.12.2024	Website opens for enabling Online Option Confirmation, rearrangement/deletion of existing higher options and for registration of fresh options to the newly included colleges- courses.
17.12.2024, 11.00 AM	Facility for Online Option Confirmation and rearrangement/ deletion/registration of options ends.
18.12.2024	Publication of second phase provisional allotment.
19.12.2024	Publication of second phase final allotment.
25.12.2024 to 28.12.2024, 4.00 PM	All candidates who get an allotment should join the course and college to which they are allotted along with the required documents and pay the fee at the colleges.
28.12.2024, 5.00 PM	College authorities shall have to approve and submit the list of admitted candidates to the CEE through the Online Admission Management System (OAMS)

Candidates allotted to courses, shall remit the prescribed fee at the college and take admission in the college-course allotted as per the schedule prescribed by the CEE. No extension of time for reporting to the college will be granted under any circumstances. Candidates are liable to pay admission fee as prescribed by the University concerned at the time of

admission.

Note:

1. Fresh option registration will be available during the third (final) Phase as per Prospectus Clause 10.1.18 (3).
2. The Government approved seat matrix of the additional seats has been published on the website.

The allotment to Colleges/Courses will be subject to recognition of All India Regulatory Bodies/Affiliation from the University concerned.
