PG MEDICAL COURSES KERALA-2024
SPECIAL STRAY VACANCY ALLOTMENT
ONLINE OPTIONS INVITED

The option registration for Special Stray Vacancy Allotment to the vacant seats in Post Graduate Medical Courses-2024 in the Medical Colleges in the State is commencing from 11.03.2025. This allotment will be conducted to fill up the currently available vacant seats. The net vacant seats after the Stray Vacancy Allotment phase have been published on the website. Candidate can register options to any seats they wish to join, if allotted. Eligible candidates included in the Kerala State Merit list published by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations can register their options through the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in from **11.03.2025 to 13.03.2025, 5.00 PM**.

Candidates may enter their Application Number & Password in the link '**PG Medical 2024 Candidate Portal**' provided in the above website to log on to their home page. By clicking the menu '**Special Stray Vacancy Registration**' candidates can register their options. The allotment will be based on the merit list and the online options received up to **5.00 PM on 13.03.2025**. Candidates who get allotment shall have to join the allotted colleges by paying the fees to the allotted college.

Tentative Schedule:

14.03.2025	Publication of Special Stray Vacancy Allotment Phase I

15.03.2025 to 17.03.2025, 3.00 PM	All candidates who get an allotment should join the course and college to which they are allotted along with the required documents and pay the fee at the colleges
17.03.2025, 4.00 PM	College authorities shall have to approve and submit the list of admitted candidates to the CEE through the OAMS
18.03.2025	Publication of Special Stray Vacancy Allotment Phase II
19.03.2025 to 20.03.2025, 4.00 PM	All candidates who get an allotment through phase II should join the course and college to which they are allotted along with the required documents and pay the fee at the colleges
20.03.2025, 5.00 PM	College authorities shall have to approve and submit the list of admitted candidates to the CEE through the OAMS

Conditions

1. Fresh Option Registration is mandatory for participating in the Special Stray vacancy filling phase allotment.
2. All candidates who wish to participate in the Special Stray vacancy filling phase shall have to pay option registration fee afresh.
3. If any candidate does not join the seat allotted in the Special Stray vacancy filling phase, the option registration fee will be forfeited and such candidates will be liable to pay liquidated damages as per Clause 10.1.19 (4) of the Prospectus and as per MCC Notice they will not be eligible to take NEET PG exam for next year, ie, NEET 2025.
4. If any candidate vacates a seat joined in Stray vacancy allotment or vacates a joined seat (joined in any of the previous phases also) after Special Stray vacancy allotment process, he/she will be liable to pay liquidated damages as per Clause 10.1.19 (4) of the Prospectus.
5. Candidates who joined the allotted seats through the allotments (First, Second, Third or Stray Vacancy Allotment) conducted by CEE and still continuing in the allotted seat are not eligible for participating in the special stray vacancy filling.
6. Candidates who have been allotted seats in the third phase and stray vacancy allotment phase are not eligible to participate in the special

stray vacancy filling.

7. Those who vacated the seat after 5:00 PM of 07.02.2025 will not be eligible to participate in the Special Stray Vacancy Filling Allotment (see notification dated 06.02.2025).
8. The options registered in the previous phases will not be considered for allotment in the special stray vacancy filling phases.
9. Those candidates who are included in the list of ineligible candidates to be shared by the MCC after the AIQ Special Stray Vacancy Round will not be considered for Allotment.

Option Registration Fee to be paid will be the amount equal to an amount of Rs.1,00,000 (Rupees One Lakhs only). Those who have paid option registration fees in the third phase, stray vacancy allotment phase but did not get any allotment need not pay the registration fees again or to pay only the balance amount as the case may be. For SC/ST/OE and other candidates who are eligible for fee concession, the registration fee will be half of the above amount. The registration fee paid will be refunded to the eligible candidates after the end of counselling. The registration fee of those candidates who do not join the seat allotted will be treated as penalty and will not be refunded.

Candidates are requested to go through the various provisions with regard to the allotment process in the Prospectus for admission to PG Medical Courses-2024 available on the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in and also requested to visit the website regularly for updates.
