ORDER

As per the Letter read as 4th paper above ,the Director , Malabar Cancer Centre - Post Graduate Institute of Oncology Sciences and Research- (MCC PGIOSR),Thalaserry has requested to include obligatory service bond for the NMC-approved Super Speciality courses conducted by the institution in the prospectus for admission for the academic year 2025-26

2) As per the prospectus for admission to Super Speciality Courses ,all candidates admitted to Government Medical Colleges will serve the Government of Kerala in Kerala in Health Service/Medical Education Service for a period not less than One Year continuously after the completion of the course .This total service rendered by him/her shall not be inclusive of obligations of compulsory bond for specialty and super-specialty courses done in Government Medical Colleges of Kerala (i.e., there shall be separate obligations of one year for both). It was also

specified in the prospectus that all students of Regional Cancer Centre-Thiruvananthapuram shall do compulsory service of not less than 1 year after their Post Graduate course in Regional Cancer Center/MCC or Respective Department of a Government Medical College.

3) As per clause 11-1.(b) of the prospectus for admission to PG Medical Courses for the academic year 2025-26 , all the General merit candidates including AIQ candidates admitted to Medical Post graduate Courses in Kerala shall serve the Government of Kerala in Medical Education Services as Senior Resident as decided by the DME/Principals of Colleges for a continuous period of not less than One year immediately after the completion of the course without break. Bonded Obligation can be fulfilled as service as Lecturer/Assistant Professor/Assistant Surgeon/Junior Consultant/Senior Resident.

4) Government have examined the matter in detail. The Malabar Cancer Centre - Post Graduate Institute of Oncology Sciences and Research (MCC-PGIOSR),Thalassery is an autonomous institution under Government of Kerala and functioning with the Plan & Non-Plan funds from the State exchequer. As per the GO read as 1st paper above, sanction was already accorded to the MCC-PGIOSR to implement obligatory service bond for all NBE courses, on par with RCC. On the basis of the Essentiality Certificate issued by the Government , the NMC has issued LOP for starting Radiation Oncology Course in the institution for the academic year 2025-26 with an annual intake of 2 seats . The fees structure for PG/ Super Speciality Courses conducted in Malabar Cancer Centre was approved as per the GO read as 5th paper above. The seat allotted to the MCC also included in seat matrix for admission to the PG courses for the academic year 2025-26.

5) In the circumstances , Government are pleased to accord sanction to extend the bonded conditions in the Prospectus for admission to PG/ Super Speciality courses in Government Medical Colleges and RCC to the PG/ Super Speciality courses in MCC-PGIOSR from the academic year 2025-26 onwards.

6) The DME / Director (MCC-PGIOSR) will take further necessary action in this regard.
