Allotment to M.Sc Nursing Course 2021-22

Online Options Invited

The Centralised Allotment Process for admission to PG Nursing (MSc. Nursing) Course in Government Nursing Colleges, Private Self-financing Nursing Colleges of the State for the academic year 2021-2022 commenced on 09.02.2022. All candidates, including Service Quota candidates, included in the rank list can register their options online through the website www.cee.kerala.gov.in from **09.02.2022 to 12.02.2022, 10 AM**. [See Clause 12 of the Prospectus]. Candidates may enter their Application Number & Password in the link ‘ **PG Nursing 2021- Candidate Portal**’ provided in the above website to log on to their home page. Then by clicking the menu item ‘**Option Registration**’, candidates can register their options online. The first allotment based on the online options received will be published on 14.02.2022.

The list of Nursing Colleges and Courses to which the Commissioner for Entrance Examination makes allotment is provided in the home page of the

candidate. Candidates can give options as per their priority of the Course-College combinations in the option list. A candidate need only give options to a Course-College combination if he / she is sure to join the course and college, if allotted. Candidates who fail to register their options online will not be considered for allotment under any circumstances. Options submitted to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations by Fax/Post/Hand delivery will not be processed or considered on any account for the allotment of seats.

SC/ST/OEC/candidates/children of Registered Fishermen/inmates of Sree Chitra Home, Nirbhayas Home, Government Juvenile Justice Homes allotted against merit seats are exempted from payment of fees. Candidates allotted to various colleges, should take admission in the colleges and shall remit the fee shown in the Allotment Memo at the college allotted as per the schedule prescribed by the CEE. No extension of time for reporting to the college will be granted under any circumstances. Candidates who receive allotment should have attained the eligibility for admission as per **Clause 7** of the Prospectus at the time of admission.

Documents to be produced at the time of admission

1. Candidate data sheet.
2. Allotment Memo issued by Commissioner for Entrance Examination.
3. Documents to prove date of birth.
4. Provisional /Degree Certificate of the qualifying examination.
5. Marklist of the qualifying examination.
6. Registration Certificate from Kerala Nurses & Midwives

Council (Renewal).

7. Registration Certificate of Addl. Qualification for candidates with Post Basic BSc (N) from KNMC.
8. Experience Certificate.
9. Certificate of Eligibility/Equivalency certificate from KUHS for candidates who have passed the qualifying examination from universities outside Kerala.
10. Transfer Certificate from the College in which the candidate last studied (If TC is not produced at the time of admission, candidate's admission will be cancelled).
11. Required bond duly filled up and signed by candidates and sureties.
12. Service Certificate (if applicable)
13. Order of relief from the Institution where they are working (in the case of service candidates).
14. Originals of all the uploaded documents / Certificates.
15. Physical fitness certificate from a Government Medical Officer not below the rank of an Assistant Surgeon.
16. Any other documents mentioned in the allotment notification/prospectus.

Candidates who do not take admission within the stipulated time shall lose their allotment as well as their registered options in the next Centralized Allotment Process (CAP).
