ADMISSION TO PG NURSING (M.Sc NURSING) COURSE-2024
MOP UP COUNSELING ALLOTMENT LIST PUBLISHED

The Mop up Allotment to fill up vacant seats in Post Graduate Nursing (M.Sc Nursing) Course in Government Nursing Colleges and Self Financing Nursing Colleges of the State for the year 2024-25 has been published. The candidates can view the allotment result in the website **www.cee.kerala.gov.in**. The allotment is based on the online options registered by candidate within the stipulated time.

Candidates can access their homepage by entering their application number and password in the '**PG Nursing -2024- Candidate Portal**' provided in the website. Then by clicking the menu '**Allotment Result**' candidates can download their Allotment Memo. The details such as candidate's name, roll number, allotment details, tuition fees, etc. are available in the Allotment Memo.

Candidates who receive allotment should report for admission to the allotted colleges on or before **28.10.2024, 12.00 Noon** along with the Allotment Memo, Data Sheet and original documents specified in Clause.12 (C) of the Prospectus. They should remit the complete fees as per Government orders in the allotted college at the time of admission. Candidates who have got a change in college from the last allotment, should collect the Transfer Certificate, original documents and Fee paid at the present college and join the newly allotted college, failing which, they will lose their current admission also.

All the College Principals should approve and submit the list of admitted

candidates through Online Admission Management System (OAMS) at **28.10.2024, 1.00 PM.**

If seats remain vacant after Mop up allotment will be filled up through institutional level vacancy filling allotment by the authorities concerned or as decided by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations.

Note: Candidates who have claimed SC/ST reservation and whose caste status is under scrutiny by KIRTADS have been provisionally considered for allotment. The allotment/admission, if any, of such candidates shall be purely provisional and subject to final verification of their caste status.
